Good Kids Isabel Jijon, 2025-07-29 One in ten children worldwide is involved in some form of child labor While almost half are in occupations that put their safety at risk the other half have gray jobs like industrial farming or selling candy on the street Children in these positions often defend the value of their work and some even join social movements to demand the right to work with dignity In *Good Kids* Isabel Jijon reveals how global campaigns against child labor are often met with resistance from the very children they are meant to protect Conducting interviews in Bolivia and Ecuador with children who defend their labor Jijon explores what they mean by value rights and dignity in this context She finds that working children seek a sense of self worth as well as worthiness in their closest relationships they use work to prove that they are good sons daughters good friends or simply good kids Drawing also on interviews with reformers invested in ending child labor Jijon produces a nuanced picture of the ways that global campaigns can unintentionally undermine these relationships and make working children feel stigmatized rather than protected This fascinating and challenging study of moral meaning making upends simple understandings of harm and worthiness in a vast but poorly understood labor market *Handbook of*

Children's rights law is often studied and perceived in isolation from the broader field of human rights law. This volume explores the interrelationship between children's rights law and more general human rights law in order to see whether elements from each could successfully inform the other. Children's rights law has a number of distinctive characteristics such as the emphasis on the best interests of the child, the use of general principles and the inclusion of third parties e.g. parents and other care takers in treaty provisions.
