In Part Two the author discusses the conceptual and clinical issues involved in the major differences between the concepts. Finally in Part Three he delineates three basic meanings of the concepts of mental objects as they have emerged in the literature and shows how they are related to ongoing issues in contemporary psychoanalysis. This long overdue clarification of a complex area with its wide-ranging and imaginative grasp of the different theories about objects will be an invaluable reference for all psychoanalysts and psychologists.
