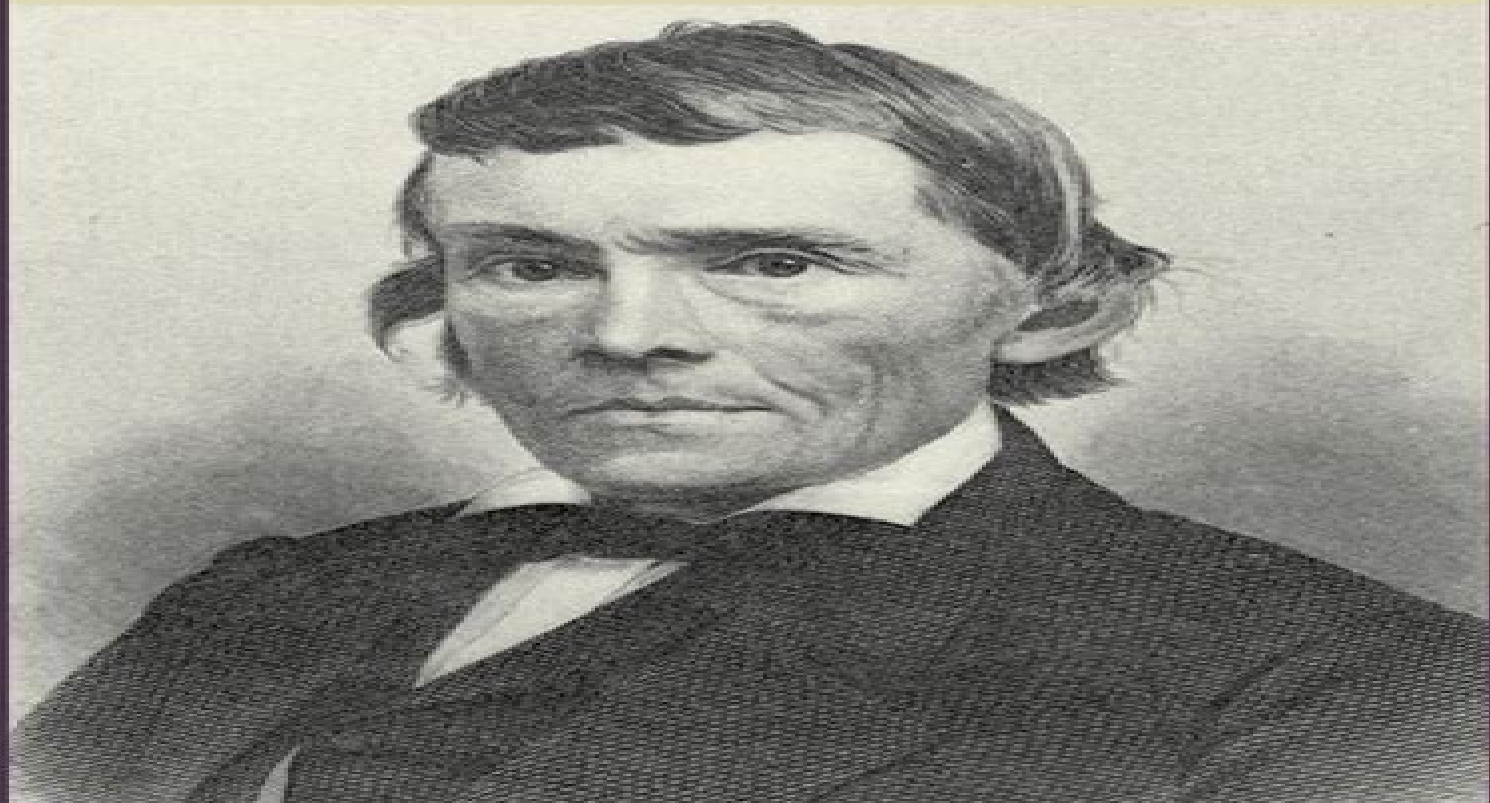


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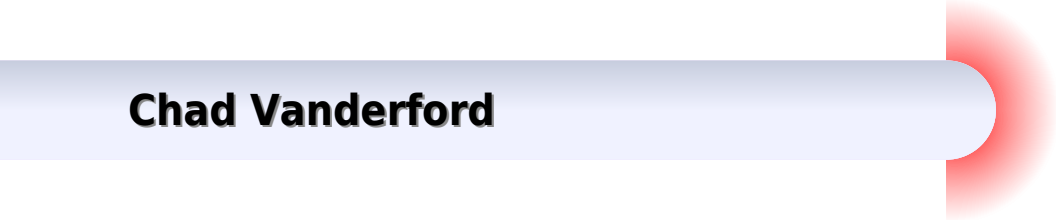

Stephens** Louis Pendleton,2020-07-05 This biography appears in the series of American Crisis Biographies The author has obtained much interesting material from files of Georgia and other Southern newspapers of the 1840 s 50 s and 60 s from old letters and scrapbooks of the war period and from manuscripts in the possession of the archives of the government at Washington Alexander H Stephens was one of the most interesting personalities in the American Civil War He was Vice President of the short lived Southern Confederacy A remarkable man in many respects his gift of eloquence gave him an almost unique position as a lawyer and his constitutional views lend a certain piquancy to the record of his public life He was not so much concerned in the retention or abolition of slavery when he assisted to fight the North as in the assertion of State rights He was their most powerful advocate and he supported the war in so far as it was intended to uphold the right to secede When the result of the war showed that might and his theory of right were on opposite sides he accepted the event however unwelcome as conclusive It is not easy for us to day to understand all that was involved in the triumph of the North and the placing of the whites of the South at the political mercy of their former slaves We get an idea from this biography A great life full of tragedy both public and private yet also full of triumph and of usefulness is Mr Pendleton s summing up A scholar a man of deep political learning of profound knowledge of constitutional history of moderate opinions and temperate spirit the Saturday Review called him when noticing his Constitutional Men of the Late War Between the States This life is worth reading first as a study of the man secondly for the light it throws on the struggle between North and South The author also delves into secession movements in the country preceeding the Southern movement particular the opposition of New England to The War of 1812 and their desire to secede as a result Very logical book not of the sentimental syrupy variety at all Well sourced and annotated **Contested Borderland** Brian D. enslavement passively and regularly demonstrated their fundamental opposition to the institution by engaging in acts of resistance which ranged from vandalism to arson to escape and on rare occasions organizing collectively against their oppression Their attempts to subvert the institution in which they were held captive not only resulted in slaveowners tightening formal and informal mechanisms of control but also generated new forms of thinking about race and slavery among whites that eventually mutated into pro slavery ideology and the myth of southern exceptionalism **"Fear God and Walk Humbly"** James Mallory,2013-09-06 A detailed journal of local national and foreign news agricultural activities the weather and family events from an uncommon Southerner Most inhabitants of the Old South especially the plain folk devoted more time to leisurely activities drinking gambling hunting fishing and just loafing than did James Mallory a workaholic agriculturalist who experimented with new plants orchards and manures as well as the latest farming equipment and techniques A Whig and a Unionist a temperance man and a peace lover ambitious yet caring business minded and progressive he supported railroad construction as well as formal education even for girls His cotton production four bales per field hand in 1850 nearly twice the average for the best cotton lands in southern Alabama and Georgia tells more about Mallory s steady work habits than about his class status But his most obvious eccentricity what gave him reason to be remembered was that nearly every day from 1843 until his death in 1877 Mallory kept a detailed journal of local national and often foreign news agricultural activities the weather and especially events involving his family relatives slaves and neighbors in Talladega County Alabama Mallory s journal spans three major periods of the South s history the boom years before the Civil War the rise and collapse of the Confederacy and the period of Reconstruction after the Civil War He owned slaves and raised cotton but Mallory was never more than a hardworking farmer who described agriculture in poetical language as the greatest interest of all **Members of Congress** Robert Goehlert,Fenton S. Old South John David Smith Charles H Stone Distinguished Professor of American History University of North Carolina at Charlotte Historians born during and after the Civil Rights movement have struggled to take the proslavery and pro secession arguments of the eighteenth and nineteenth century South seriously They generally tend to lump the two theories together as components of one ideology and then attempt to write it out of the political norms of American life In this groundbreaking study Vanderford isolates the different ideological strands in southern political thought of this era and works to understand these ideas in the context of their time St George Tucker 1752 1827 Founding Father professor and political theorist saw clearly that slavery runs against the grain of the values articulated in the Declaration of Independence Under certain narrowly construed circumstances however he thought it necessary to tolerate slavery He viewed secession as an extreme step but one that the Declaration of Independence left open as a possibility for all free states St George Tucker's arguments hinged on a modern view of natural right that builds on the premise that political power can only be legitimate if it rests on the consent of the governed He believed that equally free and independent individuals constructed a voluntary union of equally free and independent states His son Henry Tucker 1780 1848 and grandson John Randolph Tucker 1823 1897 sought to defend this ideology of modern natural right against fellow professors North and South who tended to replace it with the ancient ideology of natural right the view that wisdom gives one the title to command Many southern intellectuals came to believe that individuals are not equally free and independent by nature many northerners came to argue that the states had never been equally free and independent These disagreements contributed to the outbreak of the Civil War At once a work of intellectual history that shows the key role played by professors in helping to formulate southern ideology as well as a recovery of rarely explored arguments this work wrestles with one of the greatest challenges of intellectual history the effort to understand the most controversial ideas of the past on their own terms while searching for the genealogy that connects the past to the present CHAD VANDERFORD is an associate professor of history at the University of Texas of the Permian Basin His articles and reviews have appeared in publications including *Civil War History* the *Journal of Southern History* and the *Virginia Magazine of History and Biography* *The Political Culture of the American Whigs* Daniel Walker Howe, 1979 Howe studies the American Whigs with the thoroughness so often devoted their party rivals the Jacksonian Democrats He shows that the Whigs were not just a temporary coalition of politicians but spokesmen for a heritage of political culture received from Anglo American tradition and passed on with adaptations to the Whigs' Republican successors He relates this culture to both the country's economic conditions and its ethno-religious composition **Harper's popular cyclopedia of U.S. history** Benson John Lossing, 1889 [Confederate Veteran](#), 1987 **Parties, Slavery, and the Union in Antebellum Georgia** Anthony Gene Carey, 2012-02-01 At the heart of Georgia's secession from the Union in 1861 were two ideological cornerstones the protection of white men's liberty and the defense of African slavery Anthony Gene Carey argues in this comprehensive analytical narrative of the three decades leading up to the Civil War In Georgia broad

consensus on political essentials restricted the range of state party differences and the scope of party debate but Whigs and Democrats battled intensely over how best to protect Southern rights and institutions within the Union The power and security that national party alliances promised attracted Georgians but the compromises and accommodations that maintaining such alliances required also repelled them By 1861 Carey finds white men who were out of time fearful of further compromise and compelled to choose acted to preserve liberty and slavery by taking Georgia out of the Union Secession the ultimate expression of white unity flowed logically from the values attitudes and antagonisms developed during three decades of political strife
