The observation of poetry translation is an interdisciplinary field comprising the translation linguistic aspects of poetic language and one or more supplementary methods which enable critical assessment. This necessitates the involvement of supplementary disciplines for example reader response and its amalgamation with cognitive linguistics. Chapter One provides a short historical review of text research translation theory and cognitive linguistics highlighting the common points where possible. Chapter Two outlines the practical implementation of the research. Chapter Three outlines the common points of information processing as assumed in mental conceptual units and readers' interpretations. Chapter Four provides an outline of poetry translation with the cognitive approach to it. Chapter Five discusses the results of reception as measured through conceptualisation on the global level of the whole poem. Chapter Six is devoted to the observation of data as gained by conceptualisation on local level. Chapter Seven contains the model of poetry translation criticism which is based on 9 categories.

The Oxford Guide to Literature in English Translation Peter France, 2000. Translation has been a crucial process in world culture over the past two millennia and more. In the English speaking cultures many of the most important texts are translations from Homer to Beckett, the Bible to Freud. Although recent years have seen a boom in translation studies there has been no comprehensive yet convenient guide to this essential element of literature in English. Written by eminent scholars from many countries the Oxford Guide to Literature in English Translation meets this need and will be essential reading for all students of English and comparative literature. It highlights the place of translation in our culture encouraging awareness of the issues raised making the translator more visible. Concentrating on major writers and works it covers translations out of many languages from Greek to Korean from Swahili to Russian. For some works e.g. Virgil's Aeneid which have been much translated the discussion is historical and critical showing how translation has evolved over the centuries and bringing out the differences between versions. Elsewhere with less familiar literatures the Guide examines the extent to which translation has done justice to the range of work available. The Guide is divided into two parts. Part I contains substantial essays on theoretical questions, a pioneering outline of the history of translation into English and discussions of the problems raised by specific types of text e.g. poetry, oral literature. The second, much longer part consists of entries grouped by language of origin, some are devoted to individual texts e.g. the Thousand and One Nights or writers e.g. Ibsen, Proust but the majority offer a critical overview of a genre e.g. Chinese poetry, Spanish Golden Age drama or of a national literature e.g. Hungarian, Scottish Gaelic. There is a selective bibliography for each entry and an index of authors and translators.

assimilated Jews to recent events to the disintegration of the Dual Monarchy the collapse of law and order increased violence the reversal of Jewish emancipation and the rise of new and more pernicious antisemitic prejudices The study sees humor not only as a form of entertainment and jokes as literature and a product of popular culture but also as a heuristic device to understand the world and make sense of recent changes as well as a means to defend one's social position individual and group identity strike back at the enemy and last but not least to gain the support and change the hearts and minds of non Jews and neutral bystanders Unlike previous scholarly works on Jewish resistance during the Holocaust this study sees Budapest Jewish humor after WWI as a joint adventure as a product of urban and Hungarian culture in which Jewish not only played an important role but also cofounded Finally the book addressed the issue of continuity in Hungarian history the twisted road to Auschwitz whether urban Jewish humor as a form of escapism helped to desensitize the future victims of the Holocaust to the approaching danger or it continued to play the same defensive and positive role in the interwar period as it had done in the immediate aftermath of the Great War

It found, imagined and manufactured new borders for its travellers to cross. It celebrated and feared borders as places or states where meanings were charged and changed. In early modern Europe crossing a border could take many forms: sailing to the Americas, visiting a hospital or taking a trip through London's sewage system. Borders were places that people lived on, through and against. Some were temporary like illness while others claimed to be absolute like that between the civilized world and the savage but as the chapters in this volume show to cross any of them was an exciting, anxious and often a potentially dangerous act. Providing a trans-European interdisciplinary approach, the collection focuses on three particular aspects of travel and borders: change, status and function.
