Autour de l'extrême littéraire Alastair Hemmens, Russell Williams, 2012-12-18 The extreme is an essential aspect of contemporary experience Thrill seekers spend the weekend in the search of the adrenaline rush of extreme sports In the political arena the world has begun to rediscover the split between the extreme left and the extreme right Through 24 hour rolling news images of violence torture and war are televised unremittingly into the living room while the Internet places hardcore pornography snuff film and cannibalism within easy reach of anyone with a personal computer or a smartphone The extreme has even become a quality companies seek to associate with the most banal of commodities such as ice cream and hair gel These different manifestations of extremity suggest a contradictory even paradoxical relationship with the extreme The contributors to this book explore how writing in French from the Middle Ages to the present day has interrogated extremity Taken together these essays demonstrate that the quality of the extreme can be applied to a great number of texts for different reasons and from myriad perspectives Moreover the extreme is revealed as a quality both distinct from and in tension with the crossing of boundaries associated with transgression It is a movement towards and away from a centre of radiation that escapes cultural norms without necessarily reinforcing them This sensation of rushing and wandering outside the boundaries of what is considered safe and normal provides the extreme with its adrenaline charged response of excitement or horror The analyses contained in this volume consider a number of manifestations of the extr me litt raire The ambiguities of gender in medieval romance are explored in the context of the Arthurian court The 19th century is examined through the prose poems of Baudelaire and the litt rature sauvage of the Zutistes The difficulties of writing the trauma of war and genocide in the 20th century are discussed through the work of Jorge Sempr n and Agota Kristof The contemporary extreme in French literature is examined in the autofiction of Christine Angot the work of Annie Ernaux and Catherine Millet the controversial novels of Michel Houellebecq and the worldwide influence of the Marquis de Sade on writing today Whilst the extr me litt raire may have a wide variety of expressions in French literature it is always outside beyond and far from the centre of our everyday experience It shocks us excites us and horrifies us often all at once This book seeks to provide an insight into how and why the extreme has fascinated and continues to fascinate the French literary imagination

European Literary Immigration Into the French Language Tijana Miletic, 2008 The critical emotional and intellectual change which every immigrant is obliged to endure and confront is experienced with singular intensity by immigrant writers who have also adopted another language for their literary expression Concentrating on European authors of the second half of the twentieth century who have chosen French as a language for their literary expression and in particular the novels by Romain Gary Agota Kristof Milan Kundera and Jorge Semprun with reference to many others European Literary Immigration into the French Language explores some of the common elements in these works of fiction which despite the varied personal circumstances and literary aesthetics of the authors follow a similar path in the building of a literary identity and legitimacy

The Exile and Return of Writers from East-Central Europe John Neubauer, Borbála Zsuzsanna Török, 2009-10-28 This is the first comparative study of literature written by writers who fled from East Central Europe during the twentieth century It includes not only interpretations of individual lives and literary works but also studies of the most important literary journals publishers radio programs and other aspects of exile literary cultures The theoretical part of introduction distinguishes between exiles migr s and expatriates while the historical part surveys the pre twentieth century exile traditions and provides an overview of the exilic events between 1919 and 1995 one section is devoted to exile cultures in Paris London and New York as well as in Moscow Madrid Toronto Buenos Aires and other cities The studies focus on the factional divisions within each national exile culture and on the relationship between the various exiled national cultures among each other They also investigate the relation of each exile national culture to the culture of its host country Individual essays are devoted to Witold Gombrowicz Paul Goma Milan Kundera Monica Lovinescu Milo Crnjanski Herta M ller and to the internal exile of Imre Kert sz Special attention is devoted to the

new forms of exile that emerged during the ex Yugoslav wars and to the problems of homecoming of exiled texts and writers

Syrový, 2021-01-18 The third volume of the collected papers of the ICLA congress The Many Languages of Comparative Literature includes contributions that focus on the interplay between concepts of nation national languages and individual as well as collective identities Because all literary communication happens within different kinds of power structures linguistic economic political it often results in fascinating forms of hybridity In the first of four thematic chapters the papers investigate some of the ways in which discourses can establish modes of thinking or how discourses are in turn controlled by active linguistic interventions whether in the context of the patriarchy war colonialism or political factions The second thematic block is predominantly concerned with hybridity as an aspect of modern cultural identity and the cultural and linguistic dimensions of domestic life and in society at large Closely related a third series of papers focuses on writers and texts analysed from the vantage points of exile and exophony as well as theoretical contributions to issues of terminology and what it means to talk about transcultural phenomena Finally a group of papers sheds light on more overtly violent power structures mechanisms of exclusion Totalitarianism torture and censorship but also resistance to these forms of oppression In addition to these chapters the volume also collects a number of thematically related group sections from the ICLA congress preserving their original context **Exiles, Travellers and Vagabonds**, 2016-10-20 Travel writing migrant writing exile writing expatriate writing and even the fictional travelling protagonists that emerge in literary works from around the globe have historically tended to depict mobility as a masculine phenomenon The presence of such genres in women's writing however poses a rich and unique body of work This volume examines the texts of Francophone women who

Barta, Phil Powrie, 2015-12-22 This book focuses on literature and cinema in English or French by authors and directors not working in their native language Artists with hybrid identities have become a defining phenomenon of contemporary reality following the increased mobility between civilisations during the postcolonial period and the waves of emigration to the West Cinema and prose fiction remain the most popular sources of cultural consumption not least owing to the adaptability of both to the new electronic media This volume considers cultural products in English and French in which the explicitly multi focal representation of authors experiences of their native languages cultures makes itself conspicuous The essays explore work by the peripheral and those without a country while problematising what might be meant by the widely used but not always well defined term bicultural The first section looks at films by such well known filmmakers working in France as Bouchareb Kechiche Legzouli and Dridi as well as the animated feature *Persepolis* Here the focus is on the representation of human experience in spatial terms exploring the appropriation of territory cohabited by local people newcomers and their children haunted by the cultural memories of distant places The second part is devoted to multicultural authors whose native language was English Russian Polish Hungarian or Spanish Beckett Herzen Voeikova Triolet Conrad Hoffmann Kristof Dorfman and their creative engagement with difference A study of the emergence of multilingual writing in Montaigne and an autobiographical essay by Elleke Boehmer on growing up surrounded by English Dutch Afrikaans and Zulu frame the volume s chapters The collection relishes the freedom provided by liberation from the confines of one language and culture and the delight in creative multilingualism This book will be of significant interest to those studying the subject of biculturalism as well as the fields of comparative literature and cinema
