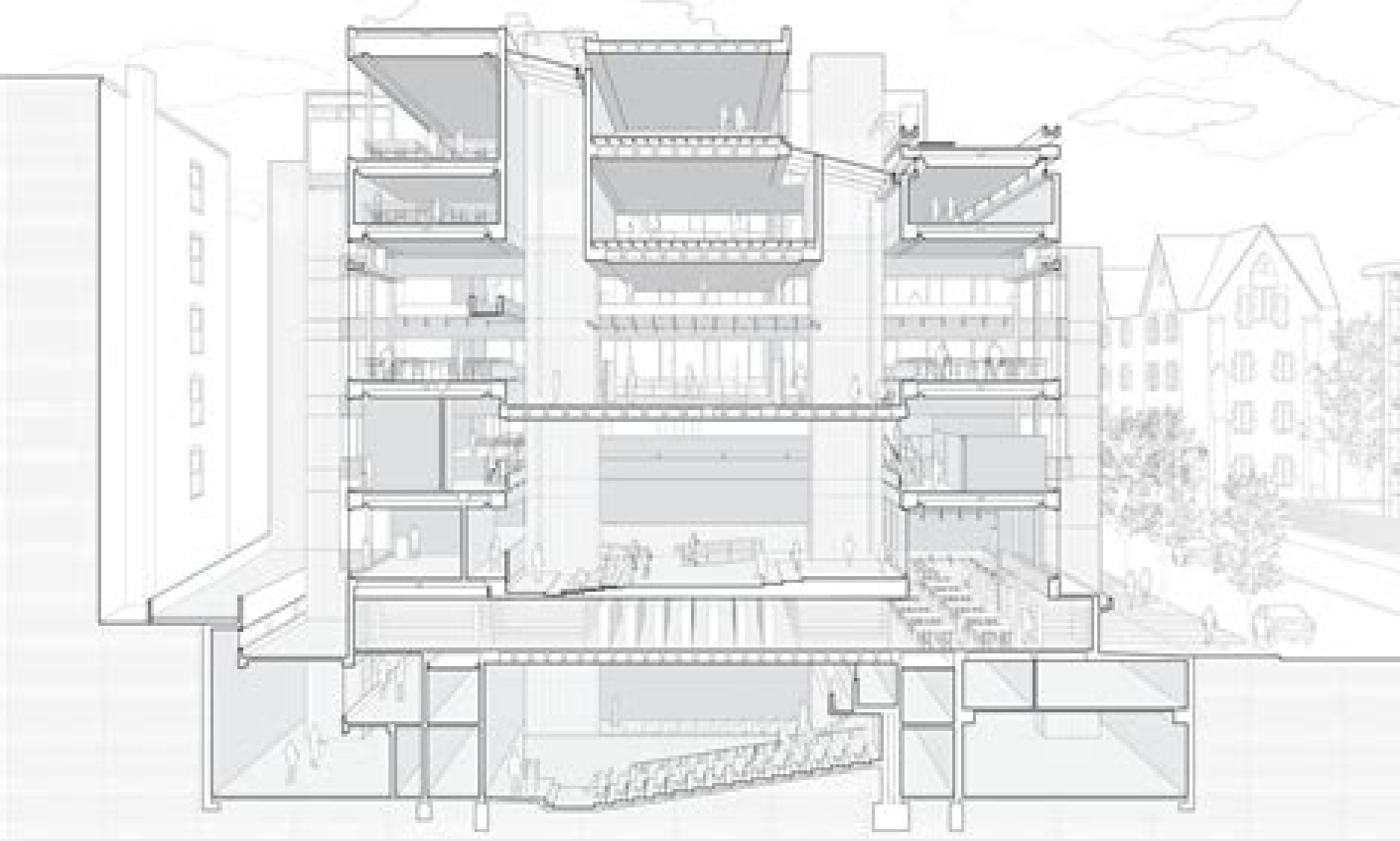




Yale Art and Architecture Building | New Haven, Connecticut, USA

Paul Rudolph | 1963

Designed and constructed during Paul Rudolph's tenure as chief of the architecture department, the iconic Art and Architecture Building (AAB) unites three levels around a central core of open, collective spaces, enclosed by a series of double-curtain walls. The exterior, which combines classical

elements, and varied forms, particularly heavy, produces a variety of mixed and varied meanings and relationships, most notably among the separate central atrium spaces and galleries, and the more peripheral and compressed studies and offices. Fragmented walls, bridges, and effects mark the relationships among

adjacent spaces while allowing for complex views through large, non-framed glass windows from deep within the exterior. Blurred lines of heavily textured, both horizontal and vertical, provide structural support for horizontal platforms, these mechanical services, and various work circulation. All the open

work, the play of horizontal planes goes up to enclosed tables/frames that bridge the vertical planes to anchor the space below. Between these tables is a collection of skylights and windows that bridge, allowing the varied spaces of this complex combination of architectural
