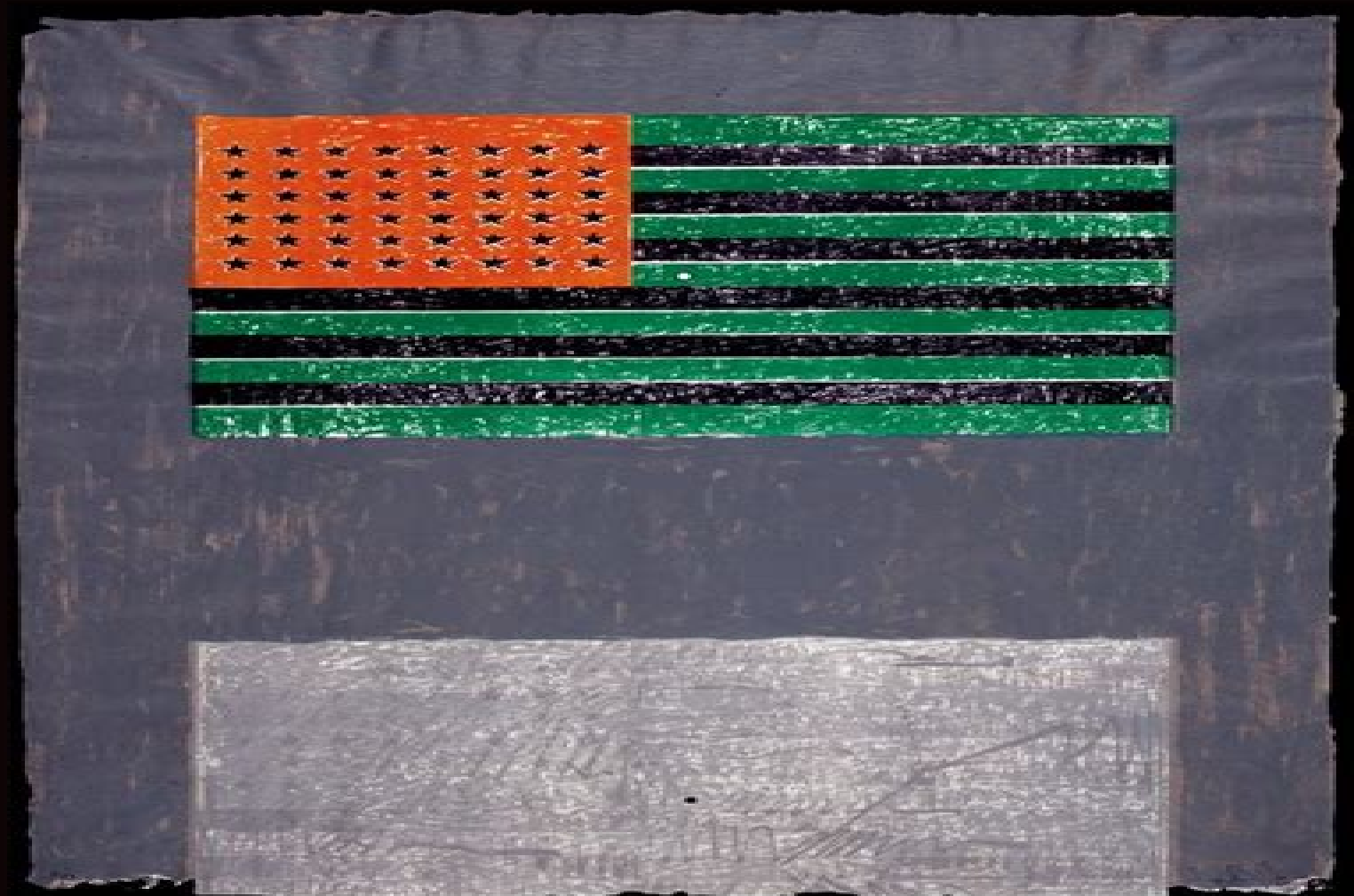

residual allegiance to empires constitutional rights that are accessible to noncitizens and the nonstate allegiance of nomadic nations Their analyses consider the inconsistencies and exceptions of national citizenship as a political concept such as overlapping jurisdictions and shared governance as well as the emergent forms of sub or supranational citizenships
