been downplayed or dismissed by many theorists Realists maintain that only powerful states assert major influence while others argue that transnational actors affect only rhetoric not policy outcomes The editors of this volume contend that transnational actors have exerted a powerful influence in postcommunist transitions They demonstrate that transitions to democracy capitalism and nation statehood which scholars thought were likely to undermine one another were facilitated by the integration of Central and East European states into an international system of complex interdependence Transnational actors turn out to be the dark matter that held the various aspects of the transition together Transnational actors include international governmental and nongovernmental organizations corporations banks foundations religious groups and activist networks among others The European Union is the most visible transnational actor in the region but there are many others including the OSCE NATO Council of Europe the Catholic Church and the Soros Foundation Transnational Actors in Central and East European Transitions assembles leading scholars to debate the role and impact of transnational actors and presents a promising new research program for the study of this rapidly transforming region

imaginative possibilities science fiction shares common ground with Gothic fiction of former centuries and the Gothic is inherent to all Banks's fiction dealing as it does with the ambiguities which wriggle uncomfortably and uncannily around the boundaries between good and evil life and death victim and villain past and present civilization and primitive barbarity organic and machine or artificial technology In most of Banks's work conventions of the Gothic boil or simmer whether it be the barbarities of the past entering the present the ambivalent literary device of the Doppelgänger or the blurred boundaries between the life of the dreaming unconscious and real life Banks incorporates the fantastic the mythological and the psychological to re-sculpt the Gothic's early fictional motifs and ethical concerns for our own time and then he projects them star-wards enabling him to elaborate a futuristic myth of socio-political salvation through technological expertise With reference to many other writers including J.G. Ballard Stephen King Doris Lessing Mary Shelley and Banks's fellow Scot Alasdair Gray this book rather in the style of the Gothic itself straddles the boundary dividing the scholastic from popular writing The style is clear and accessible and should appeal to both the academic and the general intelligent reader of Banks's work MOIRA MARTINGALE is a journalist author and former columnist for national and regional newspapers Her previous books were published in the UK by Robert Hale and internationally by various publishers She has a doctorate in Gothic Literature

Transitions and Consolidation of Democracy in Africa Samuel Ebow Quainoo,2008 What conditions motivate a transition to democracy Can the dynamics of a transition influence its outcome Under what circumstances has democracy been consolidated in Africa This trilogy of questions has become necessary in light of the current democratic wave engulfing Africa and the rest of the world In examining the conditions that initiate democratic transitions this book investigates the circumstances under which democracy movements have operated between 1980 and 1990 It concludes that contrary to dominant democratic theory the transitions to democracy in Africa have occurred under declining levels of development With regard to transitions the book recognizes that they have their own dynamics Two main types of transitions are discerned top down and bottom up The book argues that in spite of the restrictive nature of top down transitions they offer a better opportunity for democratic consolidation because of the consensus between elites of the pro democracy regime and their counterparts in the authoritarian regime a condition that is normally absent under bottom up transitions Finally relying on the cases of consolidated democracies the book derives an African democracy model The model delineates five main conditions that facilitate democratic consolidation including good leadership relevant political institutions external support civic space and a reasonable level of development It cautions however that these are not sufficient conditions nor are all of them necessary Since countries have unique historical circumstances specific countries will have to combine conditions in the model that are relevant to that society to consolidate its democracy The right combination will depend on the specific needs of the individual country
