These reflections revolve around the autographic gesture. This gesture refers to firstly the leaving of graphic traces of an embodied self which secondly transform into a drawn figure that represents this self and acquires a certain autonomy as a character and which thirdly are embedded in a narrative that tells all or part of this self's life story. By combining the semiotic logics of trace, image and narrative, the book argues autographics perform this gesture and shape a specific form of selfhood.
