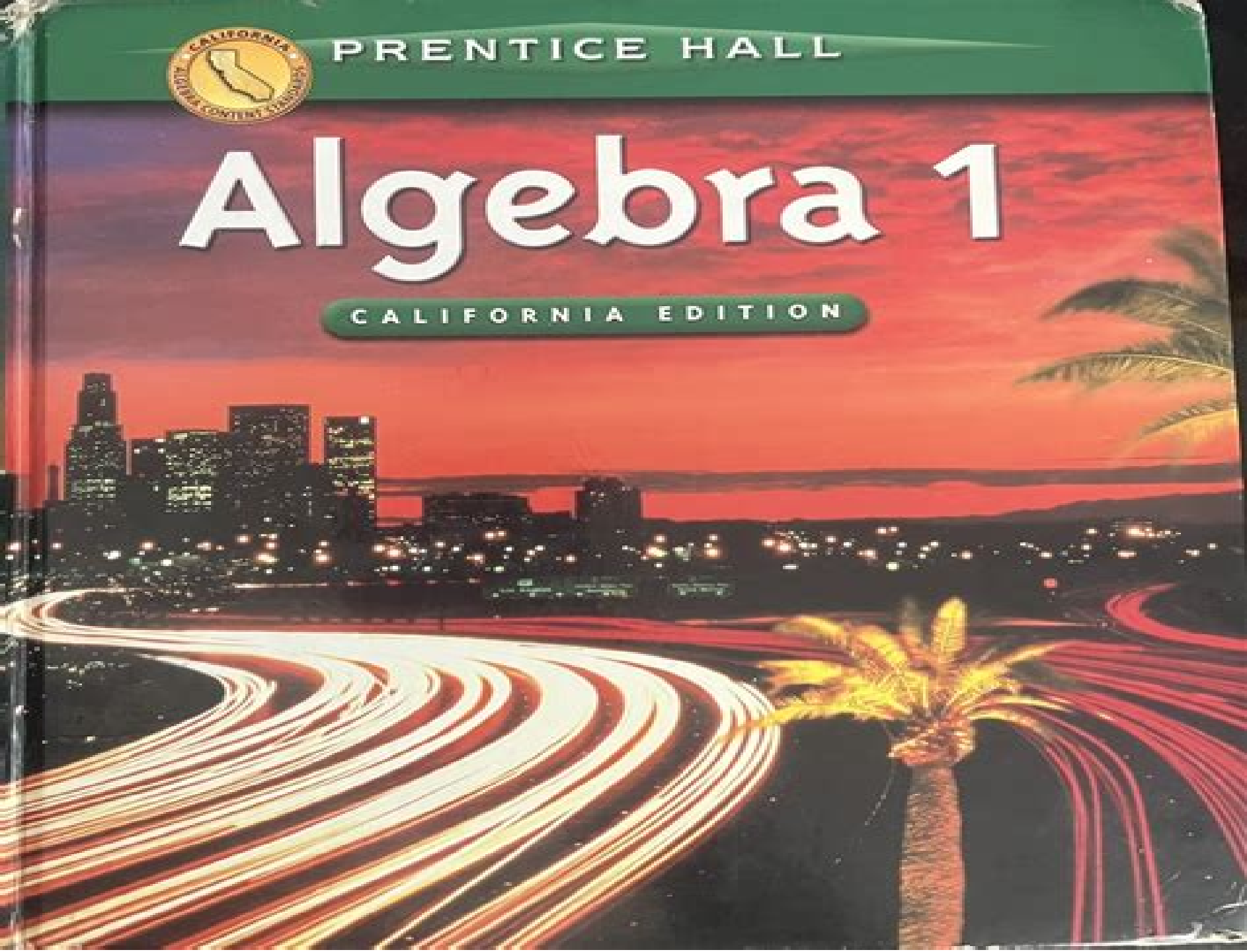

mind indeed several dozen of them field tested it The prerequisites are minimal one course in linear algebra and one course in group theory No background in graph theory or representation theory is assumed the book develops from scratch the required facts from these fields The authors include not only overviews and quick capsule summaries of key concepts but also details of potentially confusing lines of reasoning The book contains ideas for student research projects for capstone projects REUs etc exercises both easy and hard and extensive notes with references to the literature
