20th centuries Henry James said Kipling strikes me personally as the most complete man of genius as distinct from fine intelligence that I have ever known In 1907 at the age of 42 he was awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature making him the first English language writer to receive the prize and its youngest recipient to date He was also sounded out for the British Poet Laureateship and on several occasions for a knighthood both of which he declined Kipling s subsequent reputation has changed according to the political and social climate of the age and the resulting contrasting views about him continued for much of the 20th century
