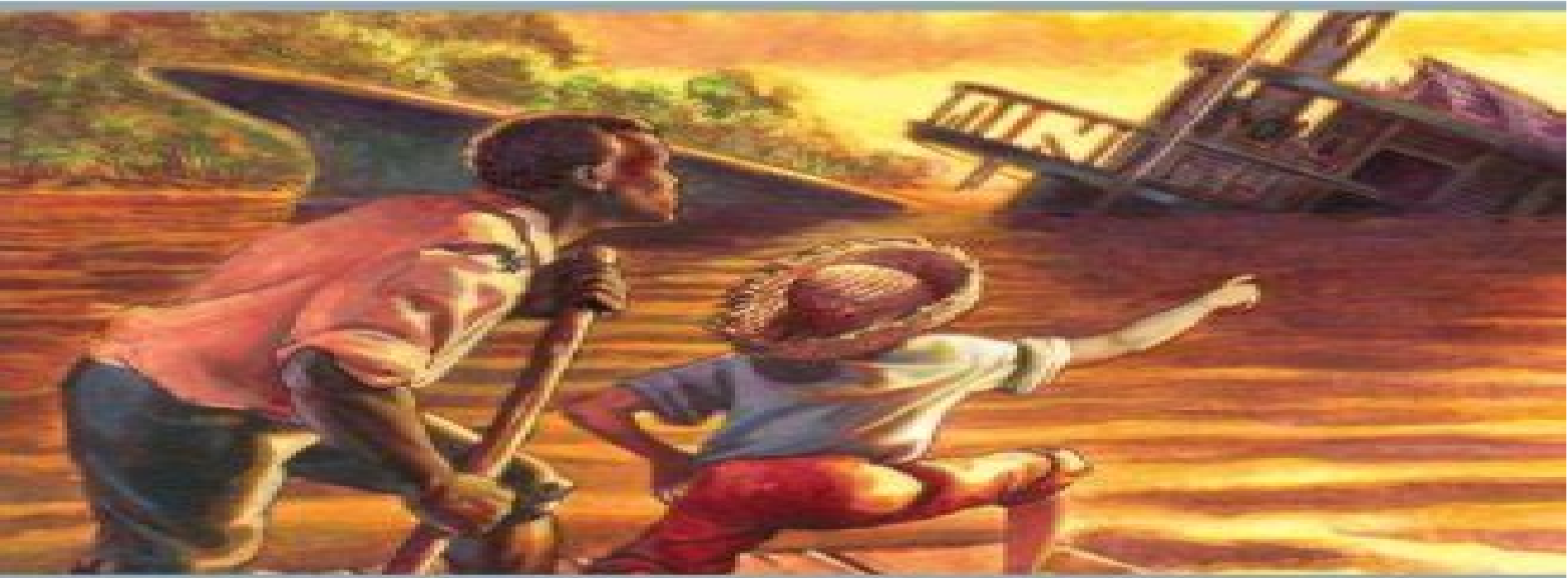

book This is an attempt to pull a book through without weather It being the first attempt of the kind in fictitious literature it
may prove a failure but it seemed worth the while of some dare devil person to try it and the author was in just the mood
