Bloody Lowndes Hasan Kwame Jeffries, 2009-07-01 Bloody Lowndes is the true story of the people of rural Lowndes County Alabama who organized a radical experiment in democratic politics in 1966 Winner of the 2010 Clinton Jackson Coley Award for the Best Book on local history from the Alabama Historical Association Early in 1966 African Americans in Lowndes County Alabama aided by activists from the Student Non Violent Coordinating Committee SNCC established an all black independent political party called the Lowndes County Freedom Organization LCFO The group whose ballot symbol was a snarling black panther was formed in part to protest the barriers to black enfranchisement that had for decades kept every single African American of voting age off the county's registration books Even after the passage of the Voting Rights Act most African Americans in this overwhelmingly black county feared violent retaliation from whites if they dared register Amid this intimidating environment the LCFO s experiment in democratic politics inspired black people throughout the country to fight for civil and human rights in new and more radical ways from SNCC organizer Stokely Carmichael who used the county's program as the blueprint for Black Power to California activists Bobby Seale and Huey P Newton who adopted the panther as the namesake for their new grassroots organization the Black Panther Party for Self Defense which became the national organization of black militancy in the 1960s and 1970s Drawing on an impressive array of sources ranging from government documents to personal interviews with Lowndes County residents and SNCC activists history professor Hasan Kwame Jeffries reveals the remarkable full story of the Lowndes County freedom struggle and its contribution to the larger civil rights movement **Black Power in the Bluff City** Shirletta Kinchen, 2024-01-12 During the civil rights era Memphis gained a reputation for having one of the South's strongest NAACP branches But that organization led by the city's black elite was hardly the only driving force in the local struggle against racial injustice In the late sixties Black Power proponents advocating economic political and cultural self determination effectively mobilized Memphis s African American youth using an array of moderate and radical approaches to protest and change conditions on their campuses and in the community While Black Power activism on the coasts and in the Midwest has attracted considerable scholarly attention much less has been written about the movement s impact outside these hotbeds In Black Power in the Bluff City Shirletta J Kinchen helps redress that imbalance by examining how young Memphis activists like Coby Smith and Charles Cabbage dissatisfied by the pace of progress in a city emerging from the Jim Crow era embraced Black Power ideology to confront such challenges as gross disparities in housing education and employment as well as police brutality and harassment Two closely related Black Power organizations the Black Organizing Project and the Invaders became central to the local black youth movement in the late 1960s Kinchen traces these groups participation in the 1968 sanitation workers strike including the controversy over whether their activities precipitated events that culminated in Martin Luther King's assassination and their subsequent involvement in War on Poverty programs The book also shows how Black Power ideology drove activism at the historically

black LeMoyne Owen College scene of a 1968 administration building takeover and at the predominately white Memphis State University where African American students transformed the campus by creating parallel institutions that helped strengthen black student camaraderie and consciousness in the face of marginalization Drawing on interviews with activists FBI files newspaper accounts from the period and many other sources the author persuasively shows not only how an emerging generation helped define the black freedom struggle in Memphis but also how they applied the tenets of Black Power to shape the broader community Shirletta J Kinchen is an assistant professor in the Pan African Studies Department at The Business of Black Power Laura Warren Hill, Julia Rabig, 2012 Explores business the University of Louisville development in the Black power era and the centrality of economic goals to the larger black freedom movement The Business of Black Power emphasizes the centrality of economic goals to the larger black freedom movement and explores the myriad forms of business development in the Black power era This volume charts a new course forBlack power studies and business history exploring both the business ventures that Black power fostered and the impact of Black power on the nation s business world Black activists pressed business leaders corporations and various levels of government into supporting a range of economic development ventures from Black entrepreneurship to grassroots experiments in economic self determination to indigenous attempts to rebuild inner city markets in thewake of disinvestment They pioneered new economic and development strategies often in concert with corporate executives and public officials Yet these same actors also engaged in fierce debates over the role of business in strengthening the movement and some African Americans outright rejected capitalism or collaboration with business The ten scholars in this collection bring fresh analysis to this complex intersection of African American and business history to reveal how Black power advocates or those purporting a Black power agenda engaged business to advance their economic political and social goals They show the business of Black power taking place in thestreets boardrooms journals and periodicals corporations courts and housing projects of America In short few were left untouched by the influence of this movement Laura Warren Hill is assistant professor of history at Bloomfield College Julia Rabig is a lecturer at Dartmouth College Ronald W.
