The software systems architecture work that is emerging and is focused either at the component level or at the systems level provides a key resource for architecting This is enhanced by the architecting techniques of RM ODP This book assembles these great ideas explains what they mean and shows how to use them for practical benefit along with real world case study examples By using the RM ODP specification constructs associated languages architecture patterns of reasoning semantic behavior specification and conformance testing abilities readers will be able to architect their specific systems based on the RM ODP specification foundations and specify architectures that work One of the purposes of this book is to provide the approach to using the RM ODP foundations in
