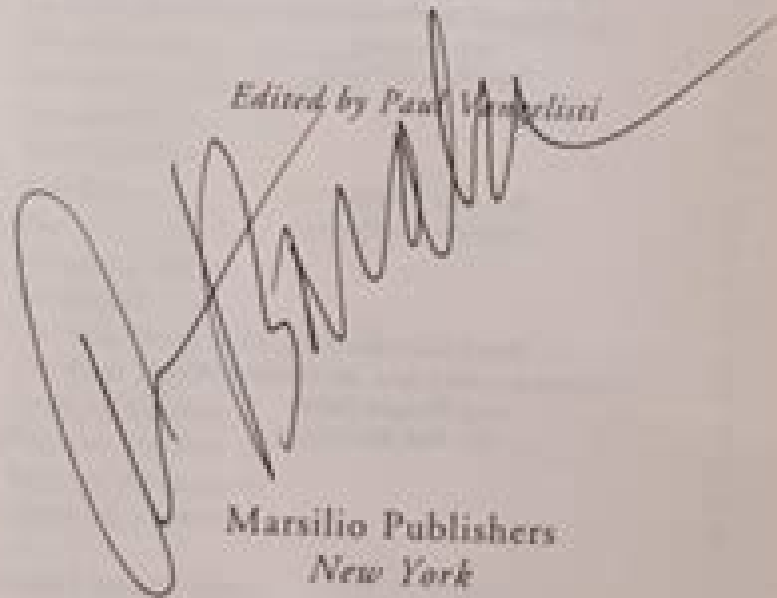
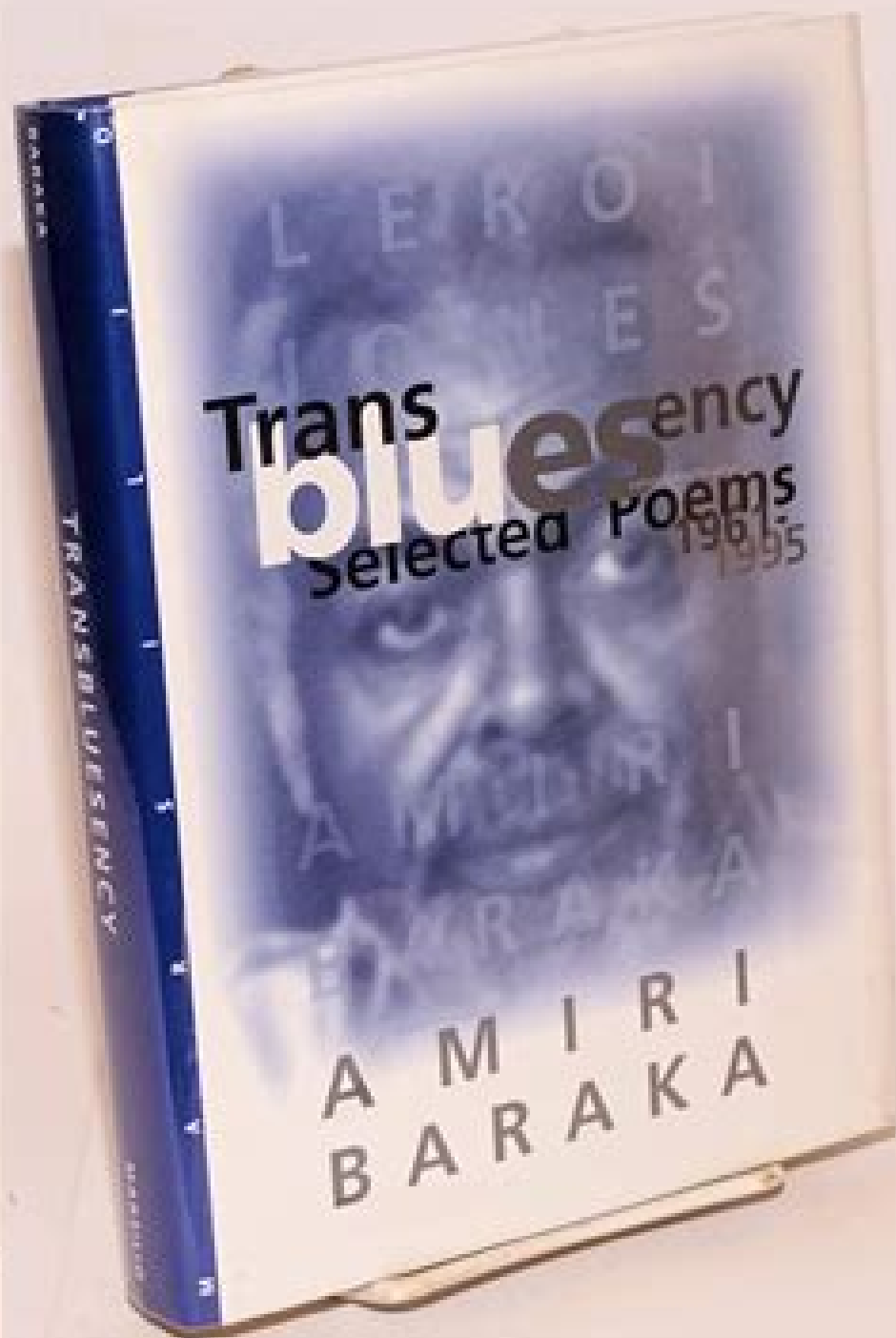

a cohesive account of a school of poets or a contribution to the boring tittle tattle of aesthetic debates over British poetry as an institution Wound Building is a front line report on the local disasters of a contemporary UK poetry caught in the grip of the historical cataclysm of capitalist culture Wound Building is further concerned with aesthetic problems related to Marxism anarchism contemporary trans politics and class though its theoretical preoccupations are subordinated to its desire to provide a ground level view on the writing itself its production its intellectual aporia and the ways it finds itself outstripped by the ongoing march of events The book will be of interest not only for those concerned with contemporary British political and experimental poetry but also more generally for anyone who wishes to think carefully about what it means to make art about present day history and its many horrible enormities The book s title is derived from the idea of sublime woundedness that subtends the context of the poets discussed here the impressions of wounds opening up like LED lit shopfronts in the night in a parallel universe in which injury is intoxicatingly impersonal and structural and which forms the environment in which the poems fight to absolutize the value of every last breath or face into the reality of extravagantly violent wish fulfillment or dissolve themselves in a search for new ways of professing love or transform into a kind of expressionism of vomiting up medical diagnostic categories found in abstract social labor or pump their verses full of the convulsive rhythms of surprise and sudden relief without any guarantee that this is the right thing to do or that anyone will even fucking hear Wound Building does not historicize this state of affairs as much as it attempts to live alongside the immediacy of this work in order to see what is still possible for poetry and criticism to make and do **Sherman Alexie** Jeff Berglund, Jan

Feedback David Joselit, 2010-02-26 In a world where politics is conducted through images the tools of art history can be used to challenge the privatized antidemocratic sphere of American television American television embodies a paradox it is a privately owned and operated public communications network that most citizens are unable to participate in except as passive speculators Television creates an image of community while preventing the formation of actual social ties because behind its simulated exchange of opinions lies a highly centralized corporate structure that is profoundly antidemocratic In Feedback David Joselit describes the privatized public sphere of television and recounts the tactics developed by artists and media activists in the 1960s and 1970s to break open its closed circuit The figures whose work Joselit examines among them Nam June Paik Dan Graham Joan Jonas Abbie Hoffman Andy Warhol and Melvin Van Peebles staged political interventions

within television's closed circuit Joselit identifies three kinds of image events feedback which can be both disabling noise and rational response as when Abbie Hoffman hijacked television time for the Yippies with flamboyant stunts directed to the media the image virus which proliferates parasitically invading transforming and even blocking systems as in Nam June Paik's synthesized videotapes and installations and the avatar a quasi-fictional form of identity available to anyone which can function as a political actor as in Melvin Van Peebles's invention of Sweet Sweetback an African American hero who appealed to a broad audience and influenced styles of Black Power activism These strategies writes Joselit remain valuable today in a world where the overlapping information circuits of television and the Internet offer different opportunities for democratic participation In *Feedback* Joselit analyzes such midcentury image events using the procedures and categories of art history The trope of figure ground reversal for instance is used to assess acts of representation in a variety of media including the medium of politics In a televisual world Joselit argues where democracy is conducted through images art history has the capacity to become a political science

Mary Turner and the Memory of Lynching Julie Buckner Armstrong, 2011

Mary Turner and the Memory of Lynching traces the reaction of activists artists writers and local residents to the brutal lynching of a pregnant woman near Valdosta Georgia In 1918 the murder of a white farmer led to a week of mob violence that claimed the lives of at least eleven African Americans including Hayes Turner When his wife Mary vowed to press charges against the killers she too fell victim to the mob Mary's lynching was particularly brutal and involved the grisly death of her eight month old fetus It led to both an entrenched local silence and a widespread national response in newspaper and magazine accounts visual art film literature and public memorials Turner's story became a centerpiece of the Anti Lynching Crusaders campaign for the 1922 Dyer Bill which sought to make lynching a federal crime Julie Buckner Armstrong explores the complex and contradictory ways this horrific event was remembered in works such as Walter White's report in the NAACP's newspaper the Crisis the Kabnis section of Jean Toomer's *Cane* Angelina Weld Grimké's short story Goldie and Meta Fuller's sculpture *Mary Turner A Silent Protest against Mob Violence* Like those of Emmett Till and Leo Frank Turner's story continues to resonate on multiple levels Armstrong's work provides insight into the different roles black women played in the history of lynching as victims as loved ones left behind and as those who fought back The crime continues to defy conventional forms of representation illustrating what can and cannot be said about lynching and revealing the difficulty and necessity of confronting this nation's legacy of racial violence
