INTRODUCTION TO THE JOINT TRAUMA SYSTEM JTS The Joint Trauma System JTS is the Department of Defense DoD authority for the military s trauma care system The vision of the Joint Trauma System is that every Soldier Sailor Marine and Airman injured on the battlefield will have the optimum chance for survival and maximum potential for functional recovery To achieve this vision in 2006 the JTS implemented programs for data driven trauma system development and improvement in addition to the collection of trauma data As part of its data collection efforts the JTS maintains a registry of trauma patients who received care at medical treatment facilities MTFs Since 2007 this registry known as the DoD Trauma
