

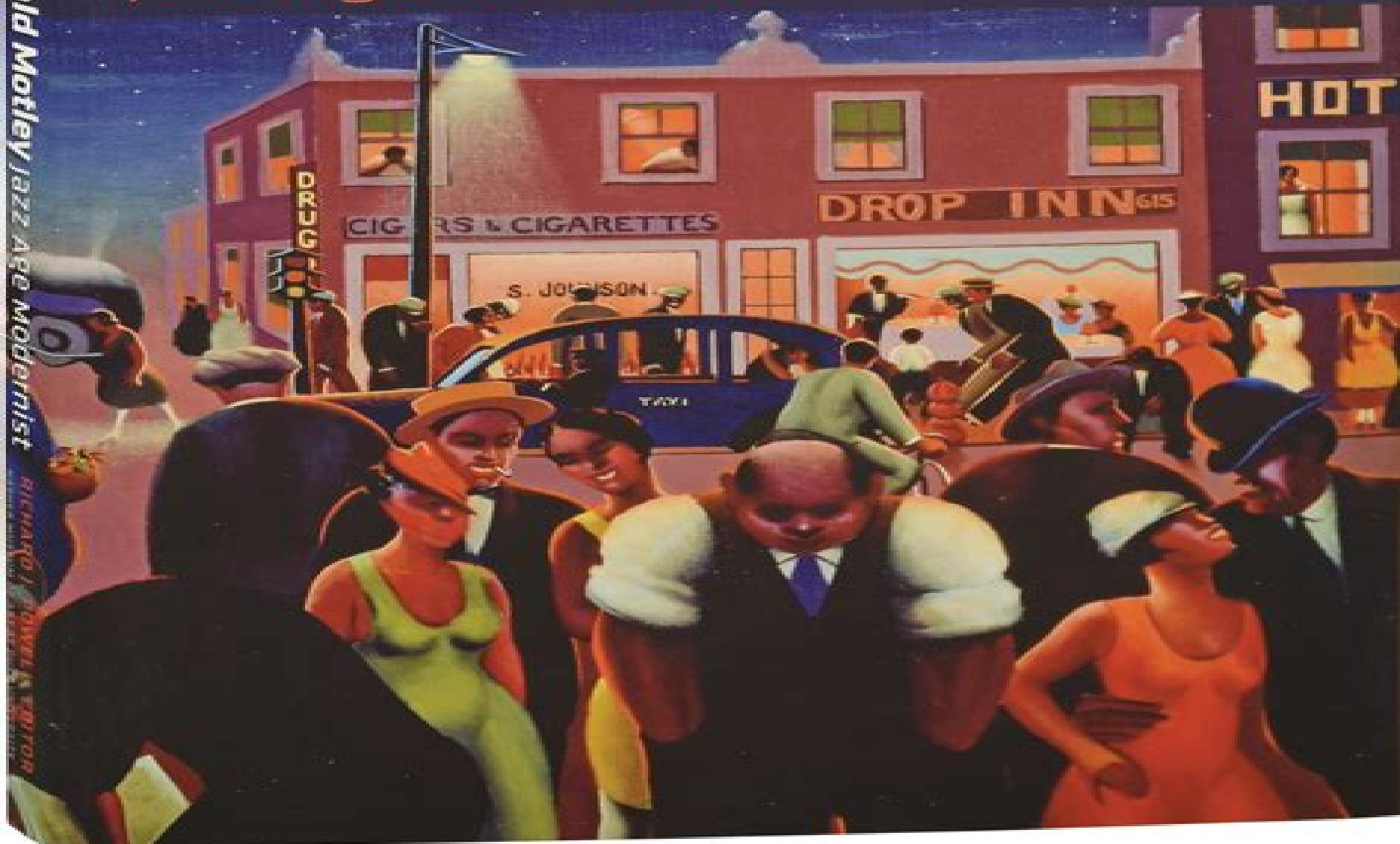

Jazz Age Chicago: Crucible of Modern America Joseph Gustaitis, 2022 When people imagine 1920s Chicago they usually and justifiably think of Al Capone speakeasies gang wars flappers and flivvers Yet this narrative overlooks the crucial role the Windy City played in the modernization of America The city's incredible ethnic variety and massive building boom gave it unparalleled creative space as design trends from Art Deco skyscrapers to streamlined household appliances reflected Chicago's unmistakable style The emergence of mass media in the 1920s helped make professional sports a national obsession even as Chicago radio stations were inventing the sitcom and the soap opera Join Joseph Gustaitis as he chases the beat of America's Jazz Age back to its jazz capital Page 4 of cover [The Harlem Renaissance and Transatlantic Modernism](#) Denise Murrell, 2024-02-25 Beginning in the 1920s Upper Manhattan became the center of an explosion of art writing and ideas that has since become legendary But what we now know as the Harlem Renaissance the first movement of international modern art led by African Americans extended far beyond New York City This volume reexamines the Harlem Renaissance as part of a global flowering of Black creativity with roots in the New Negro theories and aesthetics of Alain Locke its founding philosopher as well as the writings of W E B Du Bois Langston Hughes and Zora Neale Hurston Featuring artists such as Aaron Douglas Charles Henry Alston Augusta Savage and William H Johnson who synthesized the expressive figuration of the European avant garde with the aesthetics of African sculpture and folk art to render all aspects of African American city life this publication also includes works by lesser known contributors including Laura Wheeler Waring and Samuel Joseph Brown Jr who took a more classical approach to depicting Black subjects with dignity interiority and gravitas The works of New Negro artists active abroad are also examined in juxtaposition with those of their European and international African diasporan peers from Germaine Casse and Ronald Moody to Henri Matisse Edvard Munch and Pablo Picasso This reframing of a celebrated cultural phenomenon shows how the flow of ideas through Black artistic communities on both sides of the Atlantic contributed to international conversations around art race and identity while helping to define our notion of modernism **Archibald Motley Jr. and Racial Reinvention** Phoebe Wolfskill, 2017-08-10 An essential African American artist of his era Archibald Motley Jr created paintings of black Chicago that aligned him with the revisionist aims of the New Negro Renaissance Yet Motley's approach to constructing a New Negro a dignified figure both accomplished and worthy of respect reflected the challenges faced by African American artists working on the project of racial reinvention and uplift Phoebe Wolfskill demonstrates how Motley's art embodied the tenuous nature of the Black Renaissance and the wide range of ideas that structured it Focusing on key works in Motley's oeuvre Wolfskill reveals the artist's complexity and the variety

Berger,2025-10-31 Berger excavates the lineage of stereotype as a concept illustrating how perception of stereotypes in works of literature and fine art shifts relative to representational norms Upending a century of scholarly and popular thinking about stereotype Martin A Berger traces our

current understanding of it to the 1920s when American journalist and public intellectual Walter Lippmann borrowed the term from printmaking techniques and defined it as a shared mental picture that simplified a person event group or thing so it could be easily grasped Berger uncovers stereotype s intellectual debts to philosophy psychology political science and in particular art history and interwar racial theories *Inventing Stereotype* analyzes a series of plays novels and paintings from the 1920s and 1930s that sparked fierce debate about whether they employed racial stereotypes in the depiction of Black Jewish and other characters Through careful attention to audience responses parsed by race political leanings religion and class the book illustrates how artistic depictions are categorized as either stereotyped or not relative to current representational norms rather than to their success in conveying the authentic identities of individuals or racial groups

We Are the Culture Arionne Nettles,2024-04-16 Black Chicago culture is American culture During the Great Migration more than a half million Black Americans moved from the South to Chicago and with them they brought the blues amplifying what would be one of the city s greatest musical art forms In 1958 the iconic Johnson Publishing Company the voice of Black America launched the Ebony Fashion Fair show leading to the creation of the first makeup brand for Black skin For three decades starting in the 1970s households across the country were transported to a stage birthed in Chicago as they moved their hips in front of TV screens airing Soul Train Chicago is where Oprah Winfrey a Black woman who did not have the traditional look TV managers pushed on talent premiered her talk show which went on to break every record possible and solidify her position as the Queen of Daytime TV It s where Hall of Famer Michael Jordan led the Bulls to six championships including two three peats making the NBA a must see attraction worldwide and wearing Jordans a style symbol to this day And it s home to Grammy winner Chance the Rapper whose work honors the city s cultural institutions from the White Sox to modern art superstar Hebru Brantley Pop culture expert Arionne Nettles takes us through the history of how Black Chicagoans have led pop culture in America for decades and gives insight into the ways culture spreads and influences our lives
