of the esoteric meanings as he demands it quickly becomes evident that he intended it as a struggle between agape amour and eros Beginning it with a quote from Dante forces that into place Though the protestant forms of Christianity have changed their views on these the Roman Catholic holds fast Eliot references Michelangelo in the poem bringing in the great painter of the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel Most immediately recognize his name and work Many do not realize how he expressed a similar personal struggle between the desires of the flesh and the spirit Both of them admired Dante s Divine Comedy and its inclusion of amour as a means to salvation His work is generally seen as the greatest literature ever to come out of Italy sometimes referred to as the epic representation of St Thomas Aquinas Summa Theologica one of the central documents establishing Catholic doctrine This book explores how these brilliant men struggle with the highest meanings of life in their artistic expressions and perhaps manage to express what Rudolph Otto designates the *mysterium tremendum* the experience of a mystical awe what he calls the numinous or in more common terms the experience of God **Always**
