The **Distributive Property** is used to express a monomial-monomial or a polynomial-monomial as like terms by multiplying each factor of the polynomial. The resulting monomial is an equivalent monomial for algebraic operations. Also see the methods, page 199. In general, the Distributive Property is expressed as:

$$a(b + c) = ab + ac \quad \text{and} \quad (b + c)a = ba + ca$$

Example 1

$$2(x + 4) = 2 \cdot x + 2 \cdot 4 = 2x + 8$$

Example 2

$$3x + 7y + 10z = (2 + 1)x + 7y + 10z = 2x + 4y + 10z$$
