Arsdall, Helen Moody, 2018-12-07 Numerous Byzantine and Western sources describing the events of the Fourth Crusade have now been translated into English However the same is not true for material on Frankish Greece despite this region's importance to late medieval crusading The Chronicle of Morea is the key source for the history of the Frankish states established in Greece after the conquest of Constantinople in 1204 and their relations with the reviving Byzantine Empire during the 13th century It is also an important source for the growth of the Venetian maritime empire Most of the action centers on the Peloponnese then called Achaia or Morea where crusaders William of Champlitte and Geoffrey of Villehardouin nephew of the famous chronicler established a principality and the Villehardouins a dynasty Preserved in a unique fourteenth century manuscript the Old French version of the Chronicle of Morea is a contemporary account of Frankish feudal life transposed onto foreign soil It describes clashes conquests and ransoms between the Franks and Byzantines as well as their alliances and arranged marriages A rich source the Chronicle of Morea brims with anecdotes giving insight into the operation of feudal justice the role of noble women in feudal society the practice of chivalry and the conduct of warfare Versions of the Chronicle exist in Aragonese Greek and Italian as well as in Old French However this is the first translation into English or any other modern language of the Old French text thus opening its content to a wider audience *The Emperor Theophilos and the East, 829-842* Juan Signes Codoñer, 2016-03-23 Modern historiography has

become accustomed to portraying the emperor Theophilos of Byzantium 829 842 in a favourable light taking at face value the legendary account that makes of him a righteous and learned ruler and excusing as ill fortune his apparent military failures against the Muslims The present book considers events of the period that are crucial to our understanding of the reign and argues for a more balanced assessment of it The focus lies on the impact of Oriental politics on the reign of Theophilos the last iconoclast emperor After introductory chapters setting out the context in which he came to power separate sections are devoted to the influence of Armenians at the court the enrolment of Persian rebels against the caliphate in the Byzantine army the continuous warfare with the Arabs and the cultural exchange with Baghdad the Khazar problem and the attitude of the Christian Melkites towards the iconoclast emperor The final chapter reassesses the image of the emperor as a good ruler building on the conclusions of the previous sections The book reinterprets major events of the period and their chronology and sets in a new light the role played by figures like Thomas the Slav Manuel the Armenian or the Persian Theophobos whose identity is established from a better understanding of the sources

Bourbon families which held the Grand Mastership could legitimately claim Byzantine imperial descent albeit in the female line and the Order's cross replicates that seen by Constantine in the vision recorded by both Lactantius and Eusebius writing very soon after Maximian's defeat at the battle of the Milvian Bridge. The Order's emergence in the middle of the sixteenth century when Christian Europe was under assault from a militant Ottoman empire gained Papal support almost immediately and by the end of the seventeenth century the Order had members across the Italian peninsula in Spain Bavaria Austria and Bohemia Croatia and Poland. Today the majority of the Order's members are found in Italy and Spain but there are also members in Portugal France Belgium Great Britain and Luxembourg with smaller groups in the Netherlands Germany and Sweden as well as an expanding membership in the United States. This work examines the conversion of Constantine and the histories of the Angeli Farnese and Bourbon Grand Masterships with extensive reference to hitherto unpublished documents in the Vatican archives and in the Farnese and Bourbon archives in Naples. These serve to confirm the close relationship the Order had with the Church and the high regard in which it was held by successive Popes as well as its autonomy as a subject of canon law independent from any crown or temporal sovereignty. This unique status has enabled its hereditary Grand Masters to maintain this dignity after the absorption of the former Kingdom of the Two Sicilies into a united Italy. The Order's autonomy coupled with the Grand Master's close links to the Spanish Crown has meant that Spanish and Italian citizens as well as the citizens of several other states which have accorded the Order recognition may obtain official permission to wear the Order's decorations. 2018 is the three hundredth anniversary of the Papal Bull *Militantis Ecclesiae* which confirmed and approved the previous Papal acts concerning the Order and laid out the rights and privileges of the Order its Grand Masters and members. In the early 20th century Pope Saint Pius X and Benedict XV conferred further privileges on the Order approving the statutes while the then future Pope Pius XII had been admitted to the Order in 1913. Today the Order is engaged in works of charity in conformity with the Church's teachings and includes among its members some thirteen Cardinals as well as some thirty members of reigning or former reigning families.
