legal definition for the word necessary These three forces sometimes alone sometimes in combination repeatedly reshaped the terms on which the Bank s constitutionality was contested Lomazoff documents how these three dimensions of the polity changed over time and traces the manner in which they periodically led federal officials to adjust their claims about the Bank s constitutionality This includes the emergence of the Coinage Clause which gives Congress power to coin money regulate the value thereof as a novel justification for the institution He concludes the book by explaining why a more robust account of the national bank controversy can help us understand the constitutional basis for modern American monetary politics
