to see the actor's Falstaff on several occasions and to engage with him in discussions of how Shakespeare's plays should be performed a topic on which he had decided views Hackett's productions were only a few of those Lincoln enjoyed as president and Anderegg documents his larger theater going experience recreating the Shakespearean performances of Edwin Booth Charlotte Cushman Edwin Forrest and others as Lincoln saw them Lincoln & Liberty Lucas E.
