Unlike pesticides, the effects of which oftentimes surface years after exposure, deteriorating air quality burned the eyes and made it difficult to breathe. Polluted air, particularly in the country's urban areas, not only left an indelible impression in the minds of environmentalists but it also threatened public

health And clean water taken for granted today by most Americans is the subject of chapter six which describes the extent to which the country s waterways were part of a multibillion dollar restoration project on the part of the states mandated by the federal government The seventh chapter is a retelling of the oil spill disaster in Santa Barbara California and the radical fringe of the environmental movement which manifested itself before Earth Day a fitting precursor to the event itself the subject of the final chapter
