The Gospel Sounds Like the Witch's Spell Kiyoshi Umeza,2022-02-10 The Gospel Sounds Like the Witch s Spell is a highly detailed ethnography about how the Jopadhola in eastern Uganda talk about interpret and cope with death illness and other misfortunes The book presents a provocative discussion that critiques the idea of the revival of witchcraft in the neo liberalised contemporary world as represented by the modernity model of witchcraft and attempts to formulate a spiderweb model that connects witchcraft to contemporary society in a more complex manner The book is a unique ethnography of the collective memory of indigenous knowledge and local historicity The author moves the reader from curse to misfortune to fortune as he plots the notion of curse as deeply embedded in the Adhola way of life He weaves between culture religion state and modernity with lived experience Did the concept of witchcraft unwittingly endear the Adhola to the Christian way of life because of the presence of the notion of curse in the Bible or make them less susceptible to the vagaries of modernity compared to their neighbours These are some of the questions that the author puts on the table in a deeply reflective manner The phenomenon of witchcraft is given an intriguing angle that invites the reader to reexamine earlier anthropological writings on the subject among African peoples

Crisis of Legitimacy and Political Violence in Uganda, 1890 to 1979 Ogenga Otunnu,2016-12-26 This book demonstrates that societies experiencing prolonged and severe crises of legitimacy are prone to intense and persistent political violence The most significant factor accounting for the persistence of intense political violence in Uganda is the severe crisis of legitimacy of the state its institutions political incumbents and their challengers This crisis of legitimacy which is shaped by both internal and external forces past and present accounts for the remarkable continuity in the history of political violence since the construction of the state

King of the Mountain Arnold M. Ludwig,2002-01-01 People may choose to ignore their animal heritage by interpreting their behavior as divinely inspired socially purposeful or even self serving all of which they attribute to being human but they masticate fornicate and

procreate much as chimps and apes do so they should have little cause to get upset if they learn that they act like other primates when they politically agitate debate abdicate placate and administrate too from the book King of the Mountain presents the startling findings of Arnold M Ludwig s eighteen year investigation into why people want to rule The answer may seem obvious power privilege and perks but any adequate answer also needs to explain why so many rulers cling to power even when they are miserable trust nobody feel besieged and face almost certain death Ludwig s results suggest that leaders of nations tend to act remarkably like monkeys and apes in the way they come to power govern and rule Profiling every ruler of a recognized country in the twentieth century over 1 900 people in all Ludwig establishes how rulers came to power how they lost power the dangers they faced and the odds of their being assassinated committing suicide or dying a natural death Then concentrating on a smaller sub set of 377 rulers for whom more extensive personal information was available he compares six different kinds of leaders examining their characteristics their childhoods and their mental stability or instability to identify the main predictors of later political success Ludwig s penetrating observations though presented in a lighthearted and entertaining way offer important insight into why humans have engaged in war throughout recorded history as well as suggesting how they might live together in peace Snapshots of Great Leadership Jon P. underlying economic problems **Restructuring the African State and Quest for Regional Integration** Godfrey Mwakikagile, 2014-07-21 The author looks at different approaches towards regional and continental unity and the need to restructure the African state. He contends that reconfiguration of the African state is necessary after the institutions inherited at independence, especially centralisation of power, have failed to serve the people. He calls for decentralisation of power in order to enable the people, different groups, to set their own agenda for sustainable development. Power should be in the hands of the people at the grassroots level, using local institutions to formulate development plans, control and allocate resources in their own areas. Reconfiguration of the African state will also help to accommodate different ethnic groups on an equal basis and enable marginalised groups, especially smaller and weaker groups, to fully participate in the political process and get a fair share of the nation's resources without being dominated and exploited by others, especially dominant groups. Restructuring the state will also enable all groups to play an equal role in achieving unity, stability and development. The work is also an examination of the transition African countries have gone through since independence and the problems they have faced and continue to face in terms of nation building and trying to achieve and maintain peace and stability without which prosperity is impossible. It is a call for rebuilding Africa through a combination of innovative approaches.

Decolonising State and Society in Uganda Katherine Bruce-Lockhart, Jonathon L. Earle, Nakanyike Musisi, Edgar C. Taylor, 2022 Key book on the debates surrounding the knowledge economy and decolonization of African Studies that brings the subject up to date for the 21st century. The Deadly Ethnic Riot Donald L. Horowitz, 2023-11-15 Donald L. Horowitz's comprehensive consideration of the structure and dynamics of ethnic violence is the first full-scale comparative study of what the author terms the deadly ethnic riot: an intense, sudden, lethal attack by civilian members of one ethnic group on civilian members of another ethnic group. Serious, frequent and destabilizing, these events result in large numbers of casualties. Horowitz examines approximately 150 such riots in about fifty countries, mainly

Terrorism: An Encyclopedia of Political Violence from Ancient Times to the Post-9/11 Era James Ciment, 2015-03-10 First Published in 2015 This collection holds three volumes Terrorism is a term that defies easy definition and its meaning has also changed over the course of history Because this encyclopedia aims at comprehensiveness across time geography and the conceptual landscape it applies the broadest definition of terrorism the use of violence or the threat of violence to effect political change through fear in which the victims of the violence The encyclopedia is divided into six parts Social Origins of Violence in Uganda, 1964-1985 A. Kasozi, 1994-12-21 Using a convincing causal model of violence Kasozi attributes the major causes of violence in Uganda to social inequality the failure to develop legitimate conflict resolution mechanisms and factors that have influenced the domain and patterns of conflict in that society such as lack of a common language religious sectarianism vigilante justice and gender inequality He concludes the study by drawing comparisons with neighbouring countries and offering some prescriptions for alleviating the violence Kasozi was assisted by Nakanyike Musisi and James Mukooza Sejjengo who participated in the research on this book *The Social Origins of Violence in Uganda* is one of the most thorough and comprehensive analyses of the causes levels and incidence of more than two decades of violence in Uganda

Acholi Intellectuals Patrick William Otim, 2024-02-13 *Acholi Intellectuals* draws on the writings of homespun historians interviews with elderly men and women who remember the last days of colonial rule and government and missionary archives to illuminate the intellectual and political history of the colonial transition in northern Uganda The book focuses on Acholiland a place that has been chronically understudied in comparison to Uganda's rich fertile and well documented south Southerners there following the depictions of colonial officials and missionaries have often regarded northerners as uncultured people lacking ideas *Acholi Intellectuals* challenges this prejudice bringing into view a whole category of men and

a few women who mediated between indigenous and colonial knowledge systems and inaugurated a new kind of politics Patrick William Otim studies a category of people known as healers messengers war leaders poet musicians and diplomats who possessed prestige and power in an older Acholi political logic and who in the dawning days of colonial government came to occupy positions of power in the British administration Otim argues that these Acholi intellectuals were not simply creatures of British colonial self interest neither was their power invented by the coercive logic of indirect rule He asserts instead that people who held moral and social power in the older system were able to transform that strength under colonial administration into a new form of political legitimacy
