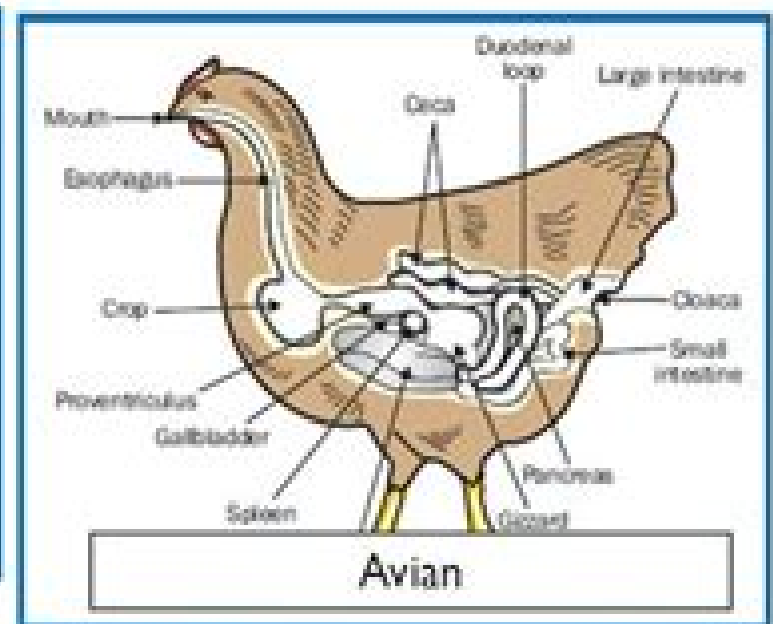


FIGURE 2. A basic diagram of the digestive system of a chicken.

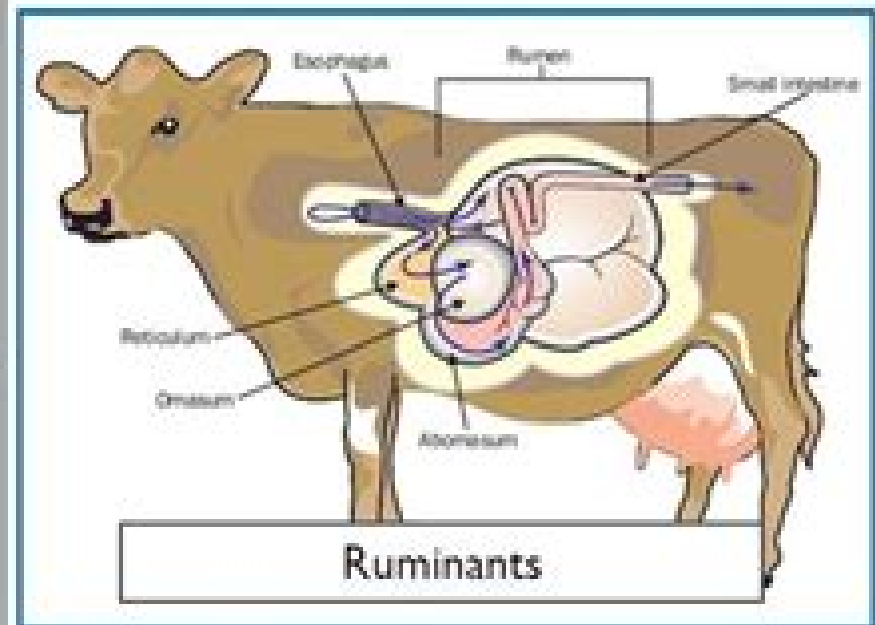
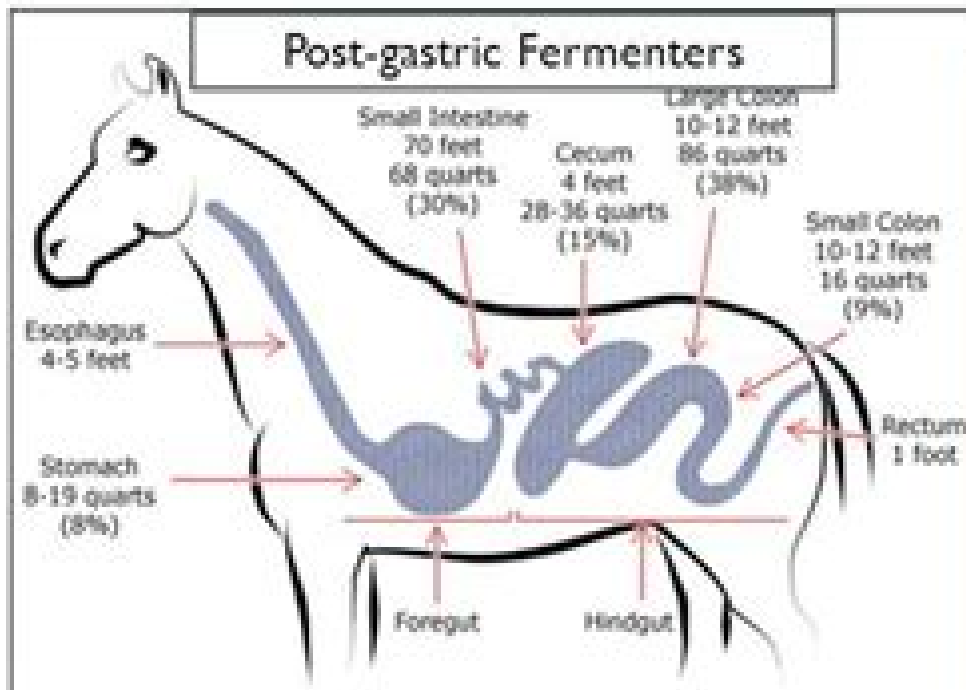


FIGURE 3. A basic diagram of the digestive system of a cow.
