Uncover the legacy of E D E N Southworth the trailblazing novelist whose daring heroines and progressive ideals captivated a generation only to be forgotten by history until now E D E N Southworth Emma Dorothy Eliza Nevitte was one of the nineteenth century's most prolific and successful authors with more novels to her credit than Nathaniel Hawthorne Herman Melville and Mark Twain combined Readers loved her feisty heroines who rode horses shot pistols captured notorious villains became sea captains and had other such grand adventures In 1859 countless readers named their daughters Capitola after their favorite character in Southworth's best selling *The Hidden Hand* In her fifty plus novels Southworth wrote about unspeakable topics for the time including alcoholism domestic violence poverty and capital punishment all nicely tucked away within the pages of her domestic fiction Despite being raised in a slave owning family she wrote for *The National Era* a known abolitionist magazine supported emancipation and encouraged her longtime friend Harriet Beecher Stowe to publish *Uncle Tom's Cabin* Southworth also advocated for better education for girls and better living conditions for the poor and joined the early women's rights movement Although Southworth achieved international fame in her lifetime knowledge of her work virtually disappeared as readers were drawn to the new Modernist literature Because Southworth never discussed her progressive views publicly a necessity as a single mother who made a living by her pen she has long been incorrectly categorized as being against causes she in fact supported Now by combining details from Southworth's novels newspapers and personal letters Rose Neal has set the record straight piecing together the fascinating life of a woman who was as determined as the heroines she created **The Hidden Hand** E D E N Southworth, 2020-05-30
The Hidden Hand or *Capitola the Madcap* is a serial novel by E D E N Southworth first published in the *New York Ledger* in 1859 and was Southworth's most popular novel It was serialized twice more first in 1868-69 and then again 1883 in slightly revised form before first appearing in book form in 1888 The novel was also serialized in the *London Guide to Literature Science Art and General Information* simultaneous to its first publication in the *New York Ledger* The name of the novel was changed to *The Masked Mother* for the London edition *The Hidden Hand* features Capitola Black a tomboyish protagonist who finds herself in a myriad of adventures Southworth stated that nearly every adventure of her heroine came from real life In the London version of the novel published by the *Guide* the characters and action were revised and relocated **E.D.E.N. The prolific nineteenth century writer E D E N Southworth enjoyed enormous public success in her day she published nearly fifty novels during her career but that very popularity combined with her gender led to her almost complete neglect by the critical establishment before the emergence of academic feminism Even now most scholarship on Southworth focuses on her most famous novel *The Hidden Hand* However this new

book the first since the 1930s devoted entirely to Southworth shows the depth of her career beyond that publication and reassesses her place in American literature Editors Melissa Homestead and Pamela Washington have gathered twelve original essays from both established and emerging scholars that set a new agenda for the study of E D E N Southworth s works Following an introduction by the editors these articles are divided into four thematic clusters The first Serial Southworth treats her fiction in periodical publication contexts Southworth s Genres the second grouping considers her use of a range of genres beyond the sentimental novel and the domestic novel In the third part Intertextual Southworth the essays present intensive case studies of Southworth s engagement with literary traditions such as Greek and Restoration drama and with her contemporaries such as Harriet Beecher Stowe and French novelist George Sand Southworth s focus on social issues and reform figures prominently throughout the volume but the pieces in the fourth section Southworth Marriage and the Law present a sustained inquiry into the ways in which marriage law and the status of women in the nineteenth century engaged her literary imagination The collection concludes with the first chronological bibliography of Southworth s fiction organized by serialization date rather than book publication For the first time scholars will be able to trace the publication history of each novel and will be able to access citations for lesser known and previously unknown works With its fresh approach this volume will be of great value to students and scholars of American literature women s studies and popular culture studies

Lillie Devereux Blake Grace Farrell,2009-09 Autograph newspaper photo and article America Lillie Devereux Blake August 12 1833 December 30 1913 was an American woman suffragist and reformer born in Raleigh North Carolina and educated in New Haven Connecticut In 1866 she married Grinfill Blake a wealthy New York merchant She was one of the active promoters of the movement that resulted in the founding of Barnard College In 1869 she visited the Women s Bureau in New York and soon after began speaking all over the United States in support of female enfranchisement She earned a reputation as a freethinker and gained fame when she attacked the well known lectures of Morgan Dix a clergyman who asserted that woman s inferiority was supported by the Bible Her lectures published as Woman s Place To Day rejected this idea asserting in one instance that if Eve was inferior to Adam because she was created after him then by the same logic Adam was inferior to the fishes Blake testified before the New York Constitutional Commission of 1873 in support for women s suffrage Along with Matilda Joslyn Gage she signed the 1876 Centennial Women s Rights Declaration She was president of the New York State Woman s Suffrage Association from 1879 to 1890 and of the New York City Woman s Suffrage League from 1886 to 1900 Blake completely broke ties with the National American Woman Suffrage Association in 1900 when Susan B Anthony who was retiring as the leader of the organization selected Carrie Chapman Catt and Anna Howard to succeed her Blake had withdrawn her candidacy in the interests of harmony For years Blake and Anthony had disagreed on the basic purpose of the women s movement Anthony wanted to focus solely on suffrage Blake wanted to pursue a broader course of reform This split in strategy was caused by a deeper theoretical divide Blake developed a theory of gender that was radical for her time She argued that gender roles are learned behaviors and that women and men shared a common nature Therefore women should have the same rights as men in all areas Anthony and her followers instead emphasized the unique nature of women their separate sphere and innate moral authority as justification for their right to suffrage This conflict among others that Blake took part in helps to explain the way she is remembered or not remembered in the context of the woman s movement Blake went on to create the National Legislative League She worked on improving immigration laws for women and furthering equality in society In addition Blake helped establish pensions for Civil War nurses and also worked on

granting mothers joint custody of their children She wanted to have women involved in civic affairs and encouraged them to study law in school She was the author of the law providing for matrons in the police stations passed in 1891 Blake was an avid writer and her writings also include *Fettered for Life* 1872 a novel dealing with the woman's suffrage question *Woman's Place To day* 1883 a series of lectures in reply to Dr Morgan Dix's Lenten sermons on the Calling of a Christian Woman A Daring Experiment 1894 P S 6 on the Upper East Side of Manhattan is named after her **The Publishers Weekly**, 1892
