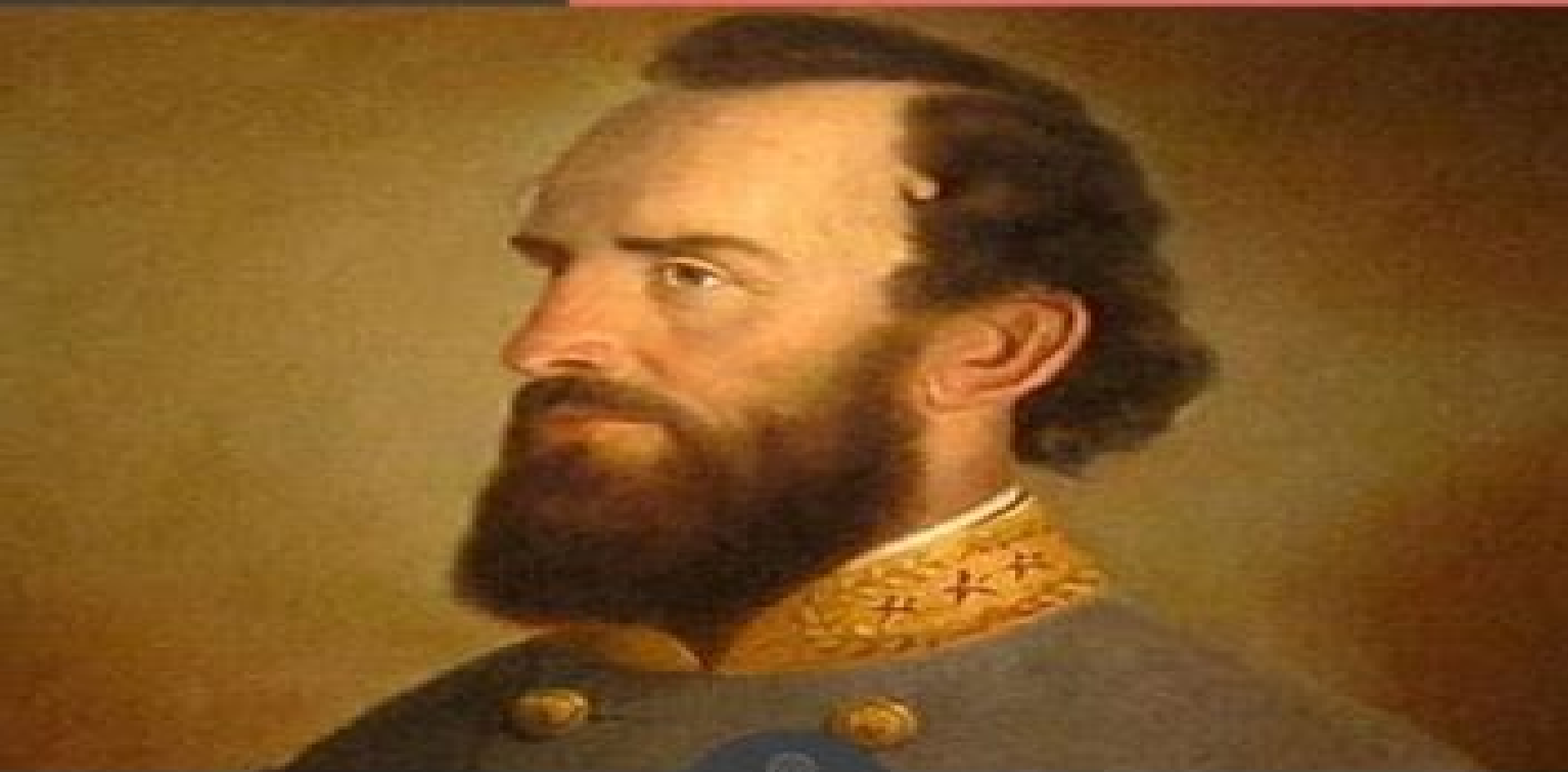


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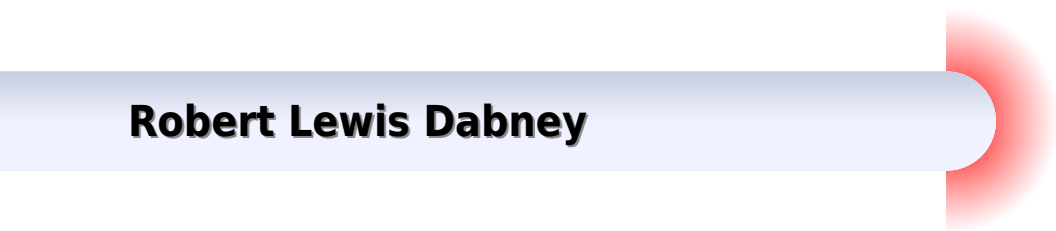

Life and Campaigns of Stonewall Jackson Robert Lewis Dabney, 2013-12 Robert Lewis Dabney was an American Christian theologian and a Southern Presbyterian pastor but he is best known for being chief of staff for General Thomas Jonathan Stonewall Jackson during his famous Valley Campaign and the Seven Days Battles Jackson was one of the most famous generals of the Civil War and one of the most successful for the Confederates Jackson got his famous nickname during the First Battle of Bull Run when another Confederate general told his men to rally behind Jackson's brigade After being the hero at Bull Run Jackson led an army in the Valley Campaign of 1862 fighting three Union armies and keeping them from linking together Jackson also participated at Second Bull Run Antietam and Fredericksburg but his most famous battle was Chancellorsville when he marched his men on a famous flank march and attack at Chancellorsville on May 2 1863 The march would end up winning the battle for the Confederates but Jackson was mortally wounded that night Dabney's biography of Jackson is invaluable to all Civil War students not only for the history but as a piece of Lost Cause literature

Cabinet's political machinations and the war's direction juggling the balancing act flawlessly. As a result, Lincoln the man is far less known than Lincoln the myth. In the 19th century, one of the surest ways to rise to prominence in American society was to be a war hero like Andrew Jackson and William Henry Harrison. But few would have predicted such a destiny for Hiram Ulysses Grant, who had been a career soldier with little experience in combat and a failed businessman when the Civil War broke out in 1861. However, while all eyes were fixed on the Eastern theater at places like Manassas, Richmond, the Shenandoah Valley, and Antietam, Grant went about a steady rise up the ranks through a series of successes in the West. His victory at Fort Donelson, in which his terms to the doomed Confederate garrison earned him the nickname "Unconditional Surrender," Grant could be considered the first major Union victory of the war, and Grant's fame and rank only grew after that. At battlefields like Shiloh and Vicksburg, Jefferson Davis, 1808-1889, holds a unique place in American history as the man best remembered for being the president of the Confederacy during the Civil War. While other famous Confederates like Robert E. Lee and Stonewall Jackson are still celebrated across the reunited country, Davis continues to be the object of scorn, derided over his attempt to flee after the Civil War and criticized as ineffective by historians. Among the Confederates still lauded by today's Southerners, Davis is well down the list. Given his Civil War legacy, which often obscures his antebellum and postwar life, it's easy to forget why Davis was made president in the first place. As a career civil servant in the United States government during much of his adult life, both as a Senator and Secretary of War, Jefferson Davis was a natural choice to be elected President of the seceding Southern states in early 1861. With the exception of George Washington, perhaps the most famous general in American history is Robert E. Lee, January 19, 1807-October 12, 1870, despite the fact he led the Confederate Army of Northern Virginia against the Union in the Civil War. As the son of U.S. Revolutionary War hero Henry Light Horse Harry Lee III and a relative of Martha Custis Washington, Lee was imbued with a strong sense of honor and duty from the beginning. And as a top graduate of West Point, Lee had distinguished himself so well before the Civil War that President Lincoln asked him to command the entire Union Army. Lee famously declined, serving his home state of Virginia instead. After it seceded, Lee is remembered today for constantly defeating the Union's Army of the Potomac in the Eastern theater from 1862-1865, considerably frustrating Lincoln and his generals. His leadership of his army led to him being deified after the war by some of his former subordinates, especially Virginians, and he came to personify the Lost Cause's ideal Southern soldier.

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
