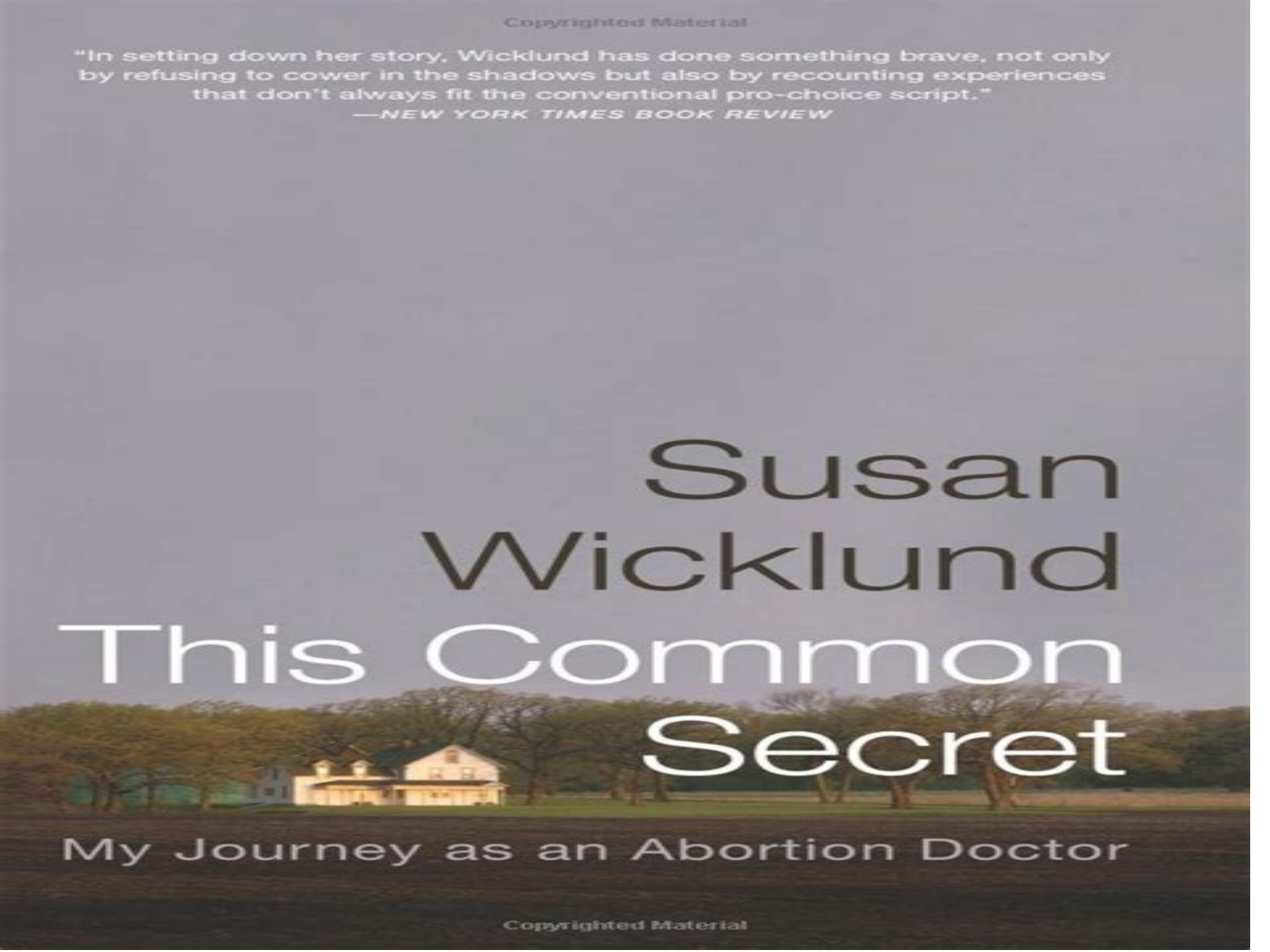

inside the facility and the gunman himself who has a vendetta to carry out. Meanwhile across the state a seventeen year old woman lands in the hospital after an attempt to self terminate her pregnancy and is subsequently charged by the pro life DA for the murder of her unborn child. They too are connected to the events unfolding in the clinic. As the book moves backward in time each chapter set one hour earlier than the last we learn how all these people and their stories are unwittingly connected and that none of these characters reasons for being where they are at this fateful place and time are exactly what it appears at first glance.

Abortion and the Private Practice of Medicine Jonathan B. Imber, 2017-01-31 Originally published in 1986 *Abortion and the Private Practice of Medicine* was the first book to look at abortion from the perspective of physicians in private practice. Jonathan B Imber spent two years observing and interviewing all twenty six of the obstetrician gynecologists in Daleton a city that did not have an abortion clinic. The decision as to whether when and how to perform abortions was therefore essentially up to the individual doctor. Imber begins the volume with a historical survey of medical views on abortion and the medical profession's response to the legalization of abortion in the United States. Quoting extensively from his interviews he looks at various characteristics of doctors that may affect their professional opinion on abortion: their age, gender, religious background and length of residence in the community, the nature of their training and prior experience and the setting of the practice, whether group or solo. Imber found that the physicians' reasons for agreeing or refusing to perform abortions revealed considerable differences of opinion about how they construe their responsibilities. Imber shows that many of the physicians he interviewed were deeply ambivalent about abortion, approving in general of a woman's right to an abortion but not wishing to perform it themselves. He argues that until abortion loses its status as a morally and politically controversial matter it will remain the doctor's dilemma. A new introduction and epilogue by the author updates this enduring controversy. He also gives a personal account of the dilemmas of writing about controversial matters as a sociologist.

Mommy Let me Live Lakisha Chapman, 2010-10-21 *Abortion after Roe* Johanna Schoen, 2015-09-28 Abortion is and always has been an arena for contesting power relations between women and men. The new material covers two important cases in detail: *Whole Woman's Health v. Hellerstedt* (2016) and *June Medical Services LLC v. Russo* (2020). The cases dealt with state laws in Texas and Louisiana, respectively, designed to limit access to abortion by requiring doctors performing abortions to

have admission privileges at a state authorized hospital within thirty miles of the abortion clinic In both cases the Court ruled the laws unconstitutional thus handing abortion rights activists key victories in the face of an increasingly conservative Court The new chapters also cover the confirmations of Justices Elena Kagan Neil Gorsuch and Brett Kavanaugh as well as the heated political environment surrounding the Court in the age of Trump
