

Nietzsche makes the important assumption that nothing is real other than our drives, passions and desires; all other things are simply those working in conjunction. Nietzsche also believes that all things in the world are based on and come from our fundamental will to power. Lastly Nietzsche makes the ironic statement of how free spirits often need masks to hide their true nature and beliefs as to not be misunderstood. However, such spirits must not let themselves be attached to anything and be constantly testing themselves; he calls the new generation of philosophers 'attempters' (Versucher) who reject dogmatism etc.
