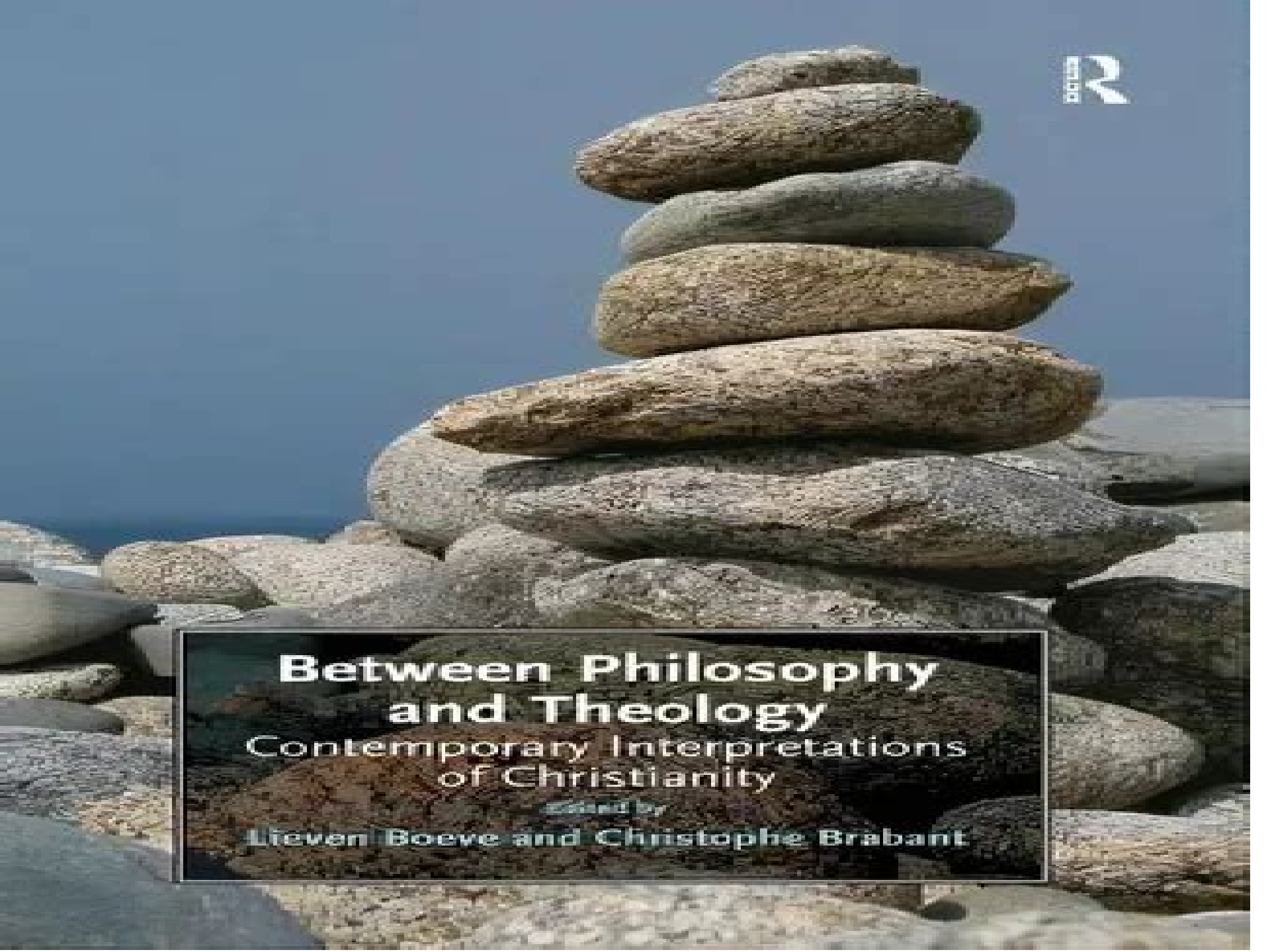

Between Philosophy and Theology Lieven Boeve, Christophe Brabant, 2010 Long past the time when philosophers from different perspectives had joined the funeral procession that declared the death of God a renewed interest has arisen in regard to the questions of God and religion in philosophy This book brings some of these philosophical views together to present an overview of the philosophical scene in its dealings with religion but also to move beyond the outsider's perspective Reflecting on these philosophical interpretations from a fundamental theological perspective the authors discover in what way these interpretations can challenge an understanding of today's faith

Continental Philosophy and Theology Colby Dickinson, 2018-06-12 Continental philosophy underwent a return to religion or a theological turn in the late 20th century And yet any conversation between continental philosophy and theology must begin by addressing the perceived distance between them that one is concerned with destroying all normative metaphysical order continental philosophy's task and the other with preserving religious identity and community in the face of an increasingly secular society theology's task Colby Dickinson argues in *Continental Philosophy and Theology* rather that perhaps such a tension is constitutive of the nature of order thinking and representation which typically take dualistic forms and which might be rethought though not necessarily abolished Such a shift in perspective even allows one to contemplate this distance as not opting for one side over the other or by striking a middle ground but as calling for a nondualistic theology that measures the complexity and inherently comparative nature of theological inquiry in order to realign theology's relationship to continental philosophy entirely

Eastern Christian Approaches to Philosophy James Siemens, Joshua Matthan Brown, 2022-10-05 With few exceptions the field of Eastern Christian studies has primarily been concerned with historical critical analysis hermeneutics and sociology For the most part it has not attempted to bring Eastern Christian philosophy into serious engagement with contemporary thought This volume seeks to redress the matter by bringing the Eastern Christian tradition into a meaningful dialogue with contemporary philosophy It boasts a diverse group of scholars specialists in ancient philosophy analytic philosophy and continental philosophy who engage with a wide range of pressing issues Among other things it addresses such topics as contemporary atheism the metaphysics of action religious epistemology the philosophy of language bioethics the philosophy of race and human rights In so doing it aims to introduce contemporary readers to unique perspectives and novel arguments often overlooked by mainstream anglophone philosophy

Radical Theology and Emerging Christianity Katharine Sarah Moody, 2016-03-03 The theological turn in continental philosophy and the turn to Paul in political philosophy have occasioned a return to radical theology a tradition whose philosophical heritage can be traced to the death of God announced in the work of Nietzsche and Hegel John D Caputo's deconstructive theology and Slavoj Žižek's materialist theology are two radical theologies that explore what it might mean to pass through the death of God and to abandon this experience as specifically Christian Radical Theology and Emerging Christianity demonstrates how these theologies are transforming everyday religious practices through an examination of the work of Peter Rollins and Kester Brewin two figures at the radical margins of a contemporary expression of Western religiosity called emerging Christianity The author uses her analysis of all four figures to argue that deconstructive practices can enable religious communities to become part of a wider materialist collective in which the death of God continues to resonate Pushing the methodological boundaries of philosophy of religion by examining religious practices as the site of philosophical signification the book challenges scholars and practitioners alike to a new and more demanding dialogue between theory and practice

The Adventure of Weak Theology ʘtefan ʘtofanić (1976–2014), 2018-10-16 tofan k provides a unique personal reading of weak theology and tries to inhabit the gap between it and its founder John D Caputo In this distinctive exploration of John D Caputo's work tofan k traces Caputo's journey of philosophical discovery from his earlier more conventional academic writings to his later almost confessional works of weak theology and his deep engagement with Derrida tofan k draws upon Caputo's life story to help explain sudden shifts in Caputo's thinking offers intricate readings of philosophical passages that have all too often been taken for granted and joins in Caputo's effort to find a theology that can be trusted and that does not rely upon dogmatic and hierarchical authority At

the same time to fan k subtly disagrees with aspects of Caputo's view and turns to the work of Antoine de Saint Exupéry as a way to suggest that one cannot take leave of the tradition of theology as easily as Caputo thinks. At times *The Adventure of Weak Theology* reads like a letter to Caputo and to fan k's own passion for theology; his deep understanding of Caputo's work and his gift for writing makes this an immensely appealing book for both admirers and critics of Caputo. tefan has read my work with extraordinary care and he has done so with a very acute ear for my authorial voice: this person whom I impersonate when I write this persona I inhabit in my books. I am not sure if this fellow who appears in print is the real me or a put on the one who I really am or the one I want to be. Either way, he only emerges or emerges best of all when I write, and tefan had a pitch-perfect ear for that voice. He didn't miss anything. He caught it every time it was important from the Afterword by John D. Caputo.

Deconstruction and the Spirit Esteban Solís, 2024-02-28 Deconstructive faith experiences are growing in number throughout global Christianity. Factors like globalization, individualism, education, post-colonial experiences, fundamentalism, connectivity, and others contribute to accelerate this trend and shape the environment of faith communities that find themselves amongst increasingly postmodern tendencies. Many pastors are deciding to ignore the situation by rejecting deconstruction altogether while others are embracing it blindly. Since an overwhelming number of churches worldwide embrace Pentecostalism, Esteban Solís proposes a pastoral response from a distinctively Pentecostal perspective that engages deconstruction of faith critically while staying open to conceive it as a tool for Spirit-led discipleship that can produce a more mature faith. By exploring a variety of authors, Solís identifies different tools that can help pastors to better understand the experience of deconstruction while engaging in discipleship practices that can produce mature believers in a postmodern era.

Sovereignty and Event Calvin D. Ullrich, 2021-01-18 In this study Calvin D. Ullrich argues for the political significance of the philosopher-theologian John D. Caputo's radical theology. Against the backdrop of present debates, the author traces the notions of sovereignty and event by drawing on the political theology of Carl Schmitt and Caputo's evolving engagement with postmodern thought from its genesis in Martin Heidegger to its deeply involved association with Jacques Derrida. Calvin D. Ullrich shows that contrary to some misleading interpretations of his religious deconstruction, Caputo has always held nascent political concerns which culminate in his radical theology.
