

Callaway, 2014-09-18 Arthur S Neubert.2009-05 Eddington FRS 1882 1944 was one of the most prominent British scientists of his time He made major contributions to astrophysics and to the broader understanding of the revolutionary theories of relativity and quantum mechanics He is famed for his astronomical observations of 1919 confirming Einstein's prediction of the curving of the paths of starlight and he was the first major interpreter of Einstein's physics to the English speaking world His 1928 book The Nature of the Physical World here re issued in a critical annotated edition was largely responsible for his fame as a public interpreter of science and has had a significant influence on both the public and the philosophical understanding of 20th century physics In degree Eddington's work has entered into our contemporary understanding of modern physics and in consequence critical attention to his most popular book repays attention Born at Kendal near Lake Windermere in the northwest of England into a Quaker background Eddington attended Owens College Manchester and afterward Trinity College Cambridge where he won high mathematical honors including Senior Wrangler He became Plumian Professor of Astronomy at Cambridge in 1913 and in 1914 Director of the Cambridge Observatory Eddington was a conscientious objector during the First World War By the end of his career he was widely esteemed and had received honorary degrees from many universities.
