The Plains Gerald Murnane, 2012-04-26 Twenty years ago when I first arrived on the plains I kept my eyes open I looked for anything in the landscape that seemed to hint at some elaborate meaning behind appearances There is no book in Australian literature like The Plains In the two decades since its first publication this haunting novel has earned its status as a classic A nameless young man arrives on the plains and begins to document the strange and rich culture of the plains families As his story unfolds the novel becomes in the words of Murray Bail a mirage of landscape memory love and literature itself
