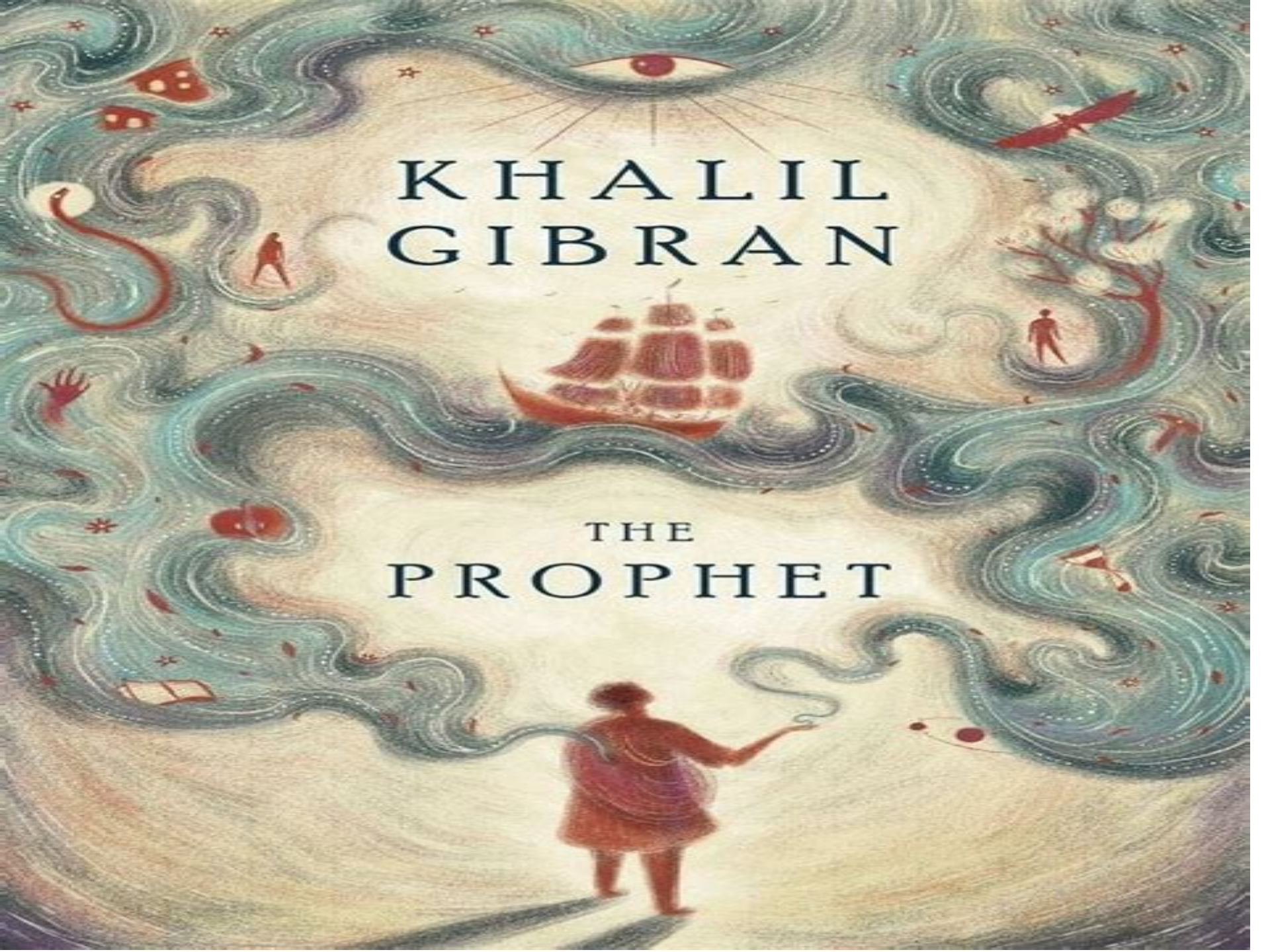

is regarded as a literary and political rebel His romantic style was at the heart of a renaissance in modern Arabic literature especially prose poetry breaking away from the classical school In Lebanon he is still celebrated as a literary hero He is chiefly known in the English speaking world for his 1923 book *The Prophet* an early example of inspirational fiction including a series of philosophical essays written in poetic English prose The book sold well despite a cool critical reception gaining popularity in the 1930s and again especially in the 1960s counterculture Gibran is the third best selling poet of all time behind Shakespeare and Laozi *The Prophet.
