author argues that this progressive policy is still rooted in a special needs education paradigm and that what was once a liberating policy has been transformed into a hegemonic tool which still manages controls and normalizes disability leaving school settings and teaching and learning routines unchanged She finally argues for a human rights approach for the development of an inclusive school for the 21st century The book is an essential reading for academics policy makers researchers and students involved in education as it links ideological pressures to practical analyses The Role of Higher Education in the Professionalisation of Adult Educators Maria N.
