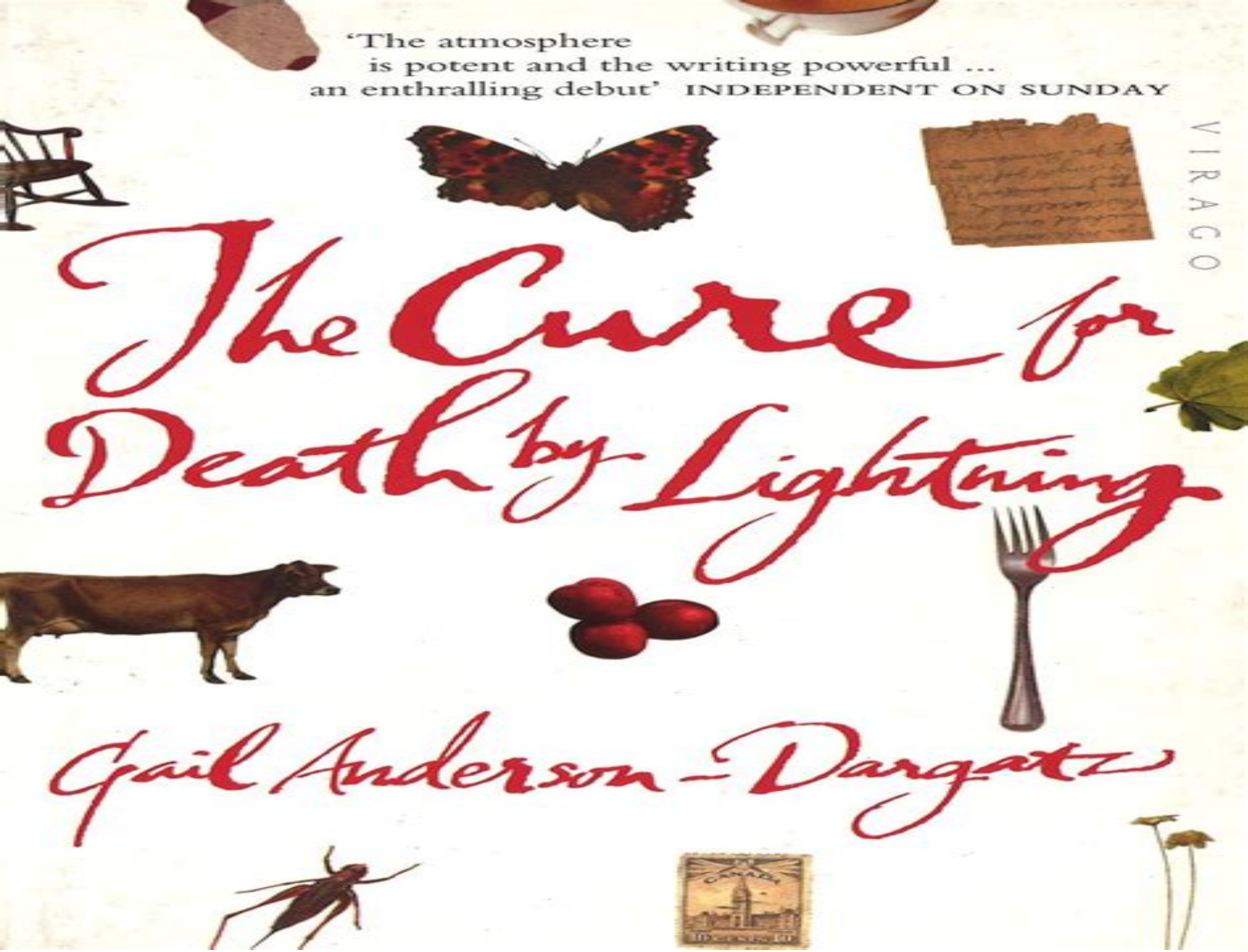

Unsettled Remains Cynthia Sugars, Gerry Turcotte, 2010-08-27 Unsettled Remains Canadian Literature and the Postcolonial Gothic examines how Canadian writers have combined a postcolonial awareness with gothic metaphors of monstrosity and haunting in their response to Canadian history The essays gathered here range from treatments of early postcolonial gothic expression in Canadian literature to attempts to define a Canadian postcolonial gothic mode Many of these texts wrestle with Canada's colonial past and with the voices and histories that were repressed in the push for national consolidation but emerge now as uncanny reminders of that contentious history The haunting effect can be unsettling and enabling at the same time In recent years many Canadian authors have turned to the gothic to challenge dominant literary political and social narratives In Canadian literature the postcolonial gothic has been put to multiple uses above all to figure experiences of ambivalence that have emerged from a colonial context and persisted into the present As these essays demonstrate formulations of a Canadian postcolonial gothic differ radically from one another depending on the social and cultural positioning of who is positing it Given the preponderance in colonial discourse of accounts that demonize otherness it is not surprising that many minority writers have avoided gothic metaphors In recent years however minority authors have shown an interest in the gothic signalling an emerging critical discourse This spectral turn sees minority writers reversing long standing characterizations of their identity as monstrous or invisible in order to show their connections to and disconnection from stories of the nation

Werewolves and Other Shapeshifters in Popular Culture Kimberley McMahon-Coleman, Roslyn Weaver, 2014-10-01 In recent years shapeshifting characters in literature film and television have been on the rise This has followed the increased use of such characters as metaphors with novelists and critics identifying specific meanings and topics behind them This book aims to unravel the shapeshifting trope Rather than pursue a case based study the works are grouped around specific themes adolescence gender sexuality race disability addiction and spirituality that are explored through the metaphor of shapeshifting Because of the transformative possibilities of this metaphor and its flexibility the shapeshifter has the potential to change how we see our world With coverage of iconic fantasy texts and a focus on current works the book engages with the shapeshifting figure in popular culture from the United States Canada the United Kingdom and Australia

[History, Literature and the Writing of the Canadian Prairies](#) Alison Calder, Robert Wardhaugh, 2005-05-16 The Canadian Prairie has long been represented as a timeless and unchanging location defined by settlement and landscape Now a new generation of writers and historians challenge that perception and argue instead that it is a region with an evolving culture and history In a collection of ten essays *History Literature and the Writing of the Canadian Prairies* explores a more contemporary prairie identity and reconfigures the prairie as a construct that is non linear

and diverse responding to the impact of geographical historical and political currents These writers explore the connections between document and imagination between history and culture and between geography and time The subjects of the essays range widely the non linear structure of Carol Shield s *The Stone Diaries* the impact of Aberhart s Social Credit Marshall McLuhan and Mesopotamian myth on Robert Kroetsch s prairie postmodernism the role of document in long prairie poems the connection between cultural tourism and heritage the theme of regeneration in Margaret Laurence s *Manawaka* writing the influence of imagination on geography in Thomas Wharton s *Icefields* and the effects on an alpine climber of pre WWII ideological concepts of time and individualism

Women's Movement Heidi Slettedahl MacPherson, 2021-07-26 *Women s Movement* critically explores the transgressive potential of feminist escape narratives and argues that they are almost by definition radically different from paradigmatic male escape narratives While definitions of escape are necessarily broad they have too often excluded the ambiguous escape the escape most closely associated with the female Indeed feminist escape narratives often resist a happy ending and *Women s Movement* argues that these narrative closures reflect the changing face of feminism as it sheds its old certainties is faced with a monumental backlash and is refigured as the potentially less threatening postfeminism Resisting the automatic association of escape with escapist *Women s Movement* analyzes male adventure and quest narratives including *Moby Dick* *The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn* *Blood Meridian* and *Deliverance* before turning to a range of feminist texts While being the first book to give critical attention to some postfeminist novels *Women s Movement* more often acts as a channel for offering different ways of approaching familiar feminist texts including among others Marian Engel s *Bear* Atwood s *Surfacing* and *The Handmaid s Tale* Joan Barfoot s *Gaining Ground* and *Dancing in the Dark* Anne Tyler s *Earthly Possessions* and *Ladder of Years* Marilynne Robinson s *Housekeeping* Erica Jong s *Fear of Flying* and Margaret Laurence s *The Diviners*

Troubling Tricksters Deanna Reder, Linda M. Morra, 2010-02-10 *Troubling Tricksters* is a collection of theoretical essays creative pieces and critical ruminations that provides a re visioning of trickster criticism in light of recent backlash against it The complaints of some Indigenous writers the critique from Indigenous nationalist critics and the changing of academic fashion have resulted in few new studies on the trickster For example *The Cambridge Companion to Native American Literature* 2005 includes only a brief mention of the trickster with skeptical commentary And in 2007 Anishinaabe scholar Niigonwedom Sinclair a contributor to this volume called for a moratorium on studies of the trickster irrelevant to the specific experiences and interests of Indigenous nations One of the objectives of this anthology is then to encourage scholarship that is mindful of the critic s responsibility to communities and to focus discussions on incarnations of tricksters in their particular national contexts The contribution of *Troubling Tricksters* therefore is twofold to offer a timely counterbalance to this growing critical lacuna and to propose new approaches to trickster studies approaches that have been clearly influenced by the nationalists call for cultural and historical specificity

Canadian Gothic Cynthia Sugars, 2014-01-15 This book explores the Gothic tradition in Canadian literature by tracing a

distinctive reworking of the British Gothic in Canada It traces the ways the Gothic genre was reinvented for a specifically Canadian context On the one hand Canadian writers expressed anxiety about the applicability of the British Gothic tradition to the colonies on the other they turned to the Gothic for its vitalising rather than unsettling potential After charting this history of Gothic infusion Canadian Gothic turns its attention to the body of Aboriginal and diasporic writings that respond to this discourse of national self invention from a post colonial perspective These counter narratives unsettle the naturalising force of this invented history rendering the sense of Gothic comfort newly strange The Canadian Gothic tradition has thus been a conflicted one which reimagines the Gothic as a form of cultural sustenance This volume offers an important reconsideration of the Gothic legacy in Canada DisPossession Marlene Goldman,2012 An exploration into the darker aspects of contemporary Canadian fiction

Animal Fiction in Late Twentieth-Century Canada Alice Higgs,2023-11-09 *Animal Fiction in Late Twentieth Century Canada* fulfils a vital contribution to the conversation surrounding animal representation as a point of continuity in national narratives and supports the idea that focusing on narratives of responsibility and care influences better relations with both non human animals and across settler Indigenous boundaries Alice Higgs engages with on going debates regarding reconciliation by demonstrating that it is imperative to critique settler colonial environmental frameworks and place autonomy back into Indigenous communities by bringing Indigenous practices of custodianship and relationality to bear more generally This book also develops a number of conversations in animal studies in relation to the politics of representation Higgs studies a range of canonical Canadian

authors demonstrating a progress across the period in which it is possible to identify the emergence of a literary pro animal turn

Margaret Atwood and the Female Bildungsroman Ellen McWilliams, 2017-03-02 Examining Margaret Atwood's work in the context of the complex history of the Bildungsroman Ellen McWilliams explores how the genre has been appropriated by women writers in the second half of the twentieth century She demonstrates that Atwood's early work her own coming of age fiction including unpublished works as well as *The Edible Woman* *Surfacing* and *Lady Oracle* both engages with and works against the paradigms of identity which are traditionally associated with the genre Making extensive use of unpublished manuscripts in the Atwood Collection at the University of Toronto McWilliams uncovers influences that shaped Atwood's fashioning of identity in her early novels paying particular attention to Atwood's preoccupation with survival as a key symbol of Canadian literature culture and identity She also considers the genre's afterlife on display in *Cat's Eye* *The Robber Bride* *Alias Grace* *The Blind Assassin* and *Moral Disorder* in which the formulations of selfhood and identity in Atwood's early fiction are revisited and developed Atwood emerges as a writer who self consciously invokes and then undercuts the traditions of the Bildungsroman a turn that may be read as a means of at once interrogating and perpetuating the form McWilliams's book furthers our understanding of subjectivity in Atwood's fiction and contributes to ongoing conversations about the role gender and cultural contexts play in reframing generic boundaries
