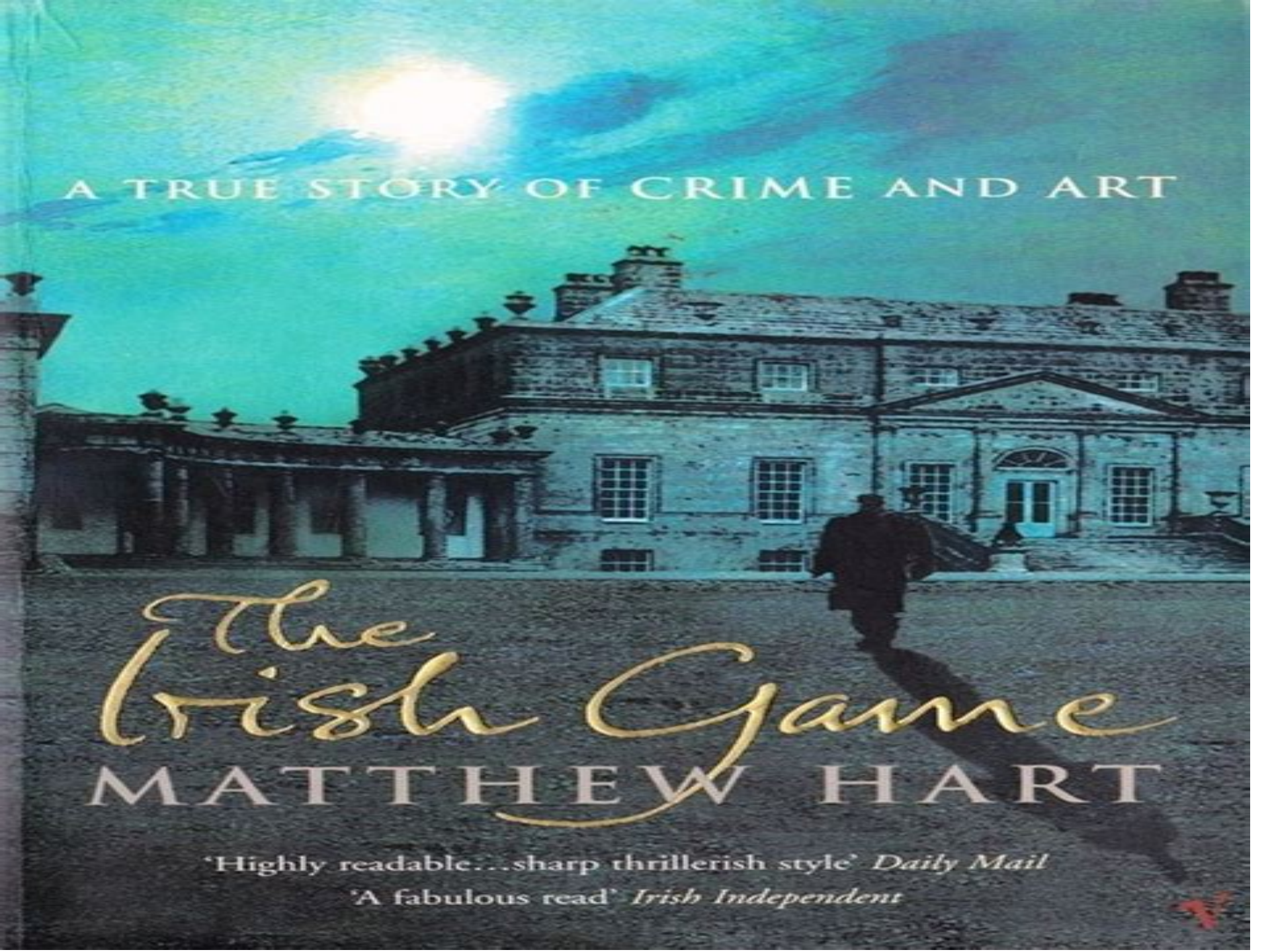

Schwarz's pluralistic self-questioning approach to what he calls reading texts and reading lives quite relevant to the current historical moment and political situation. A legendary scholar of modernist literature, Schwarz's critical principles are a healthy corrective to cultural hubris. The essayists treat works ranging from fictions by Joyce, Conrad, Morrison, and Woolf to the poetry of Yeats to Holocaust literature to the environmental writings of Wendell Berry to the photographs of Lee Friedlander. Like Schwarz, the essays look for intentionality of authorial meaning rather than something called an author function as well as for the relationship between lived experience and the imagined world of the literary work rather than the endless semiotic play of an ultimately indecipherable text.
