The Last Gentleman Walker Percy, 2011-03-29 National Book Award Finalist A lonely Southerner forges a surprising bond with a New York family in this brilliant novel by the author of *The Moviegoer* Time Will Barrett has never felt at peace After moving from his native South to New York City Will's most meaningful human connections come through the lens of a telescope in Central Park from which he views the comings and goings of the eccentric Vaught family But Will's days as a spectator end when he meets the Vaught patriarch and accepts a job in the Mississippi Delta as caretaker for the family's ailing son Jamie Once there he is confronted not only by his personal demons but also his growing love for Jamie's sister Kitty and a deepening relationship with the Vaught family that will teach him the true meaning of home *The Last Gentleman* Walker Percy, 1989 Will Barrett's unusual capacity for forgetting and imagining features of his own life involves him in the affairs of a Southern family *Walker Percy's Voices* Michael Kobre, 2000 Walker Percy's novels are fraught with characters struggling toward a destiny and purpose in life who must sort through conflicting inner voices and the voices of family friends therapists and mentors until they finally find their own paths Through trial error and retrial Percy's characters continuously reinvent themselves struggling until they reach solutions satisfaction and maturity In this multifaceted work Michael Kobre analyzes Walker Percy's major fiction works *The Moviegoer* *The Last Gentleman* *Love in the Ruins* *Lancelot* *The Second Coming* and *The Thanatos Syndrome* in terms of the Russian philosopher and literary scholar Mikhail Bakhtin's critical theory Kobre begins with an introduction to Percy's view of language and consciousness and a clear accessible explanation of Bakhtin's ideas His subsequent discussion of the novels connects each work in turn with Percy's advancing career and explores the deepening conflict in Percy's fiction between his desire to express his own religious and moral beliefs and his commitment to the essential freedom of his art the play of many voices in his narratives **Walker Percy's *The Last Gentleman***, 1969 ***The Art of Walker Percy*** Panthea Reid Broughton, 1999-03-01 The writings of Walker Percy as Panthea Broughton notes in her introduction are at once both accessible and inaccessible Because they tempt readers to identify with characters and recognize ideas they have gained a large and enthusiastic following But because they are subtle and complicated they defy attempts to reduce them to transparencies Indeed Percy's fiction and nonfiction have a curious baffling quality that eludes all but the most scrupulously thoughtful and sensitive readers Through his close alignment with European novelists and philosophers this native of Alabama has given to American fiction a classic tone that is lacking in the work of such twentieth century writers as Hemingway and Fitzgerald In *The Art of Walker Percy* Broughton has brought together essays from fifteen scholars Writing from a conviction of the centrality and worth of Walker Percy's work as well as from the idea that fresh criticism is of value not only to readers but to living authors as well the essayists present diverse approaches to understanding his art Cleanth Brooks in his essay compares Percy with Eric Voegelin and notes the similarity of their respective approaches to the moral problems of modern man Martin Luschei in an examination of the technique of

The Moviegoer shows how Percy presents his fictional world through the use of filmic art William Poteat's critique of The Message in the Bottle deals with Percy's original contribution to the philosophy of language Ted Spivey offers a structuralist analysis of Percy's work and suggests that in Lancelot Percy's quest takes a new direction Still other contributors approach Percy through more traditional rubrics such as the South Kierkegaard's stages dualism and theology in new and revelatory ways Written specifically for this new collection their essays present the reader with a sense of how many appropriate stratagems there are for seeing the meaning in Percy As they bring his work into focus therefore they assist Walker Percy in his avowed strategy of helping us see the world

Mittendorf,1997 The Oxford Book of the American South resonates with the words of black people and white women and men the powerless as well as the powerful The collection presents the most telling fiction and nonfiction produced in the South from the late eighteenth century to the present Renowned authors such as James Agee Richard Wright Maya Angelou Lee Smith Eudora Welty William Faulkner and Flannery O'Connor appear in these pages but so do people whose writing did not immediately reach a large audience For example Harriet A Jacobs book Incidents in the Life of a Slave Girl which is now recognized as one of the most illuminating narratives of a former slave was neglected for generations And Sarah Morgan's powerful Civil War Diary has only recently come to widespread attention The Oxford Book of the American South presents compelling autobiographies diaries memoirs and journalism as well as stories and selections from novels and runs the spectrum from the conservative to the radical the traditional to the innovative Editors Edward L Ayers and Bradley C Mittendorf have arranged these diverse readings so that they fit together into a rich mosaic of Southern life and history The sections of the book The Old South The Civil War and Its Consequences Hard Times and The Turning unfold a vivid record of life below the Mason Dixon line We see the antebellum period both from the perspective of those who experienced it first

hand such as Thomas Jefferson and former slaves Olaudah Equiano and Frederick Douglass and then from the perspective of authors looking back on that era including William Styron and Sherley Anne Williams Likewise we see the Civil War through the eyes of witnesses such as Sam Watkins through the eyes of later writers trying to make sense of the conflict such as Robert Penn Warren and through the eyes of those using the war's intense passions to fuel their fiction such as Margaret Mitchell and Barry Hannah The classic authors of the Southern Renaissance in the 1920s and 1930s appear here in the context of the hard times in which they wrote The years since World War II are chronicled in the powerful words of Martin Luther King Jr's Letter from Birmingham Jail George Garrett's Goodbye Goodbye Be Always Kind and True and Peter Taylor's The Decline and Fall of the Episcopal Church in the Year of Our Lord 1952 The editors have selected these readings their Preface tells us to convey the passions that have surfaced time and again in more than two hundred years of Southern writing Indeed the struggles defeats and triumphs chronicled in The Oxford Book of the American South speak not just to the South but to all of the American experience They document and evoke some of the most dramatic episodes in the nation's life

Walker Percy Gary M. Ciuba, 2010-09-01 In Walker Percy Books of Revelations Gary M Ciuba examines how Percy's apocalyptic vision inspires the structure themes and strategies of his fiction This book explores the unity of the southern novelist's fiction by focusing on its religious and artistic design one of the first studies to approach Percy's work from this perspective Ciuba considers Percy's six published novels The Moviegoer The Last Gentleman Love in the Ruins Lancelot The Second Coming and The Thanatos Syndrome and also offers the first extended critical analysis of his unpublished work The Gramercy Winner Although the novels are often seen as increasingly satiric jeremiads about the possible doom of America Ciuba argues that Percy's fiction is principally shaped by a demythologized and partially realized form of eschatology This apocalyptic vision has less to do with the end of the external world than with the demise of the protagonists' internal worldviews According to Ciuba Percy does more than offer direly comic warnings about the end of the world he shows how the world actually ends and then may begin again in the everyday lives and extraordinary loves of his astonished seers

Walker Percy William Rodney Allen, 1986 **Three Catholic Writers of the Modern South**, 1985 **Walker Percy's Search for Community** John F. Desmond, 2004 In this criticism of Percy John F Desmond traces the writer's enduring concerns with community These concerns Desmond argues were grounded in the realism of such Scholastics as Aquinas and Duns Scotus The Percys of Mississippi Lewis Baker, 1999-03-01 Set in the twilight years of southern aristocracy The Percys of Mississippi is a biography of a family in whose bloodline ran both a strong commitment to public service and an equally strong but more private dedication to literature Following four generations of Percy family history Lewis Baker chronicles the lives and public careers of Colonel William Alexander Percy a planter and lawyer his son LeRoy a lawyer and United States Senator LeRoy's son Will a poet and lawyer and Will's nephew and adopted son the novelist Walker Percy Known as the gray eagle of the delta for his piercing eyes and silver hair Colonel Percy served as a Confederate officer in

both the eastern and western campaigns of the Civil War He returned home to practice law and manage the family's property but he was soon drawn into the arena of state politics where he fought vigorously to strengthen the Mississippi River levee system and to protect his district from the perils of Reconstruction With Colonel Percy's death in 1888 LeRoy Percy inherited his father's law practice and his mantle of leadership in the community LeRoy used his power as a United States Senator to continue his father's long quest for an adequate levee system struggled to loosen the Ku Klux Klan's grip of fear on the delta and campaigned tirelessly to discredit the divisive creed of the state's rising demagogue politicians In the election of 1911 LeRoy Percy was defeated in his bid to be returned to the Senate losing to the flamboyant demagogue James Kimble Vardaman the White Chief It was a defeat echoed across the South throughout the dawning years of the twentieth century as poorer whites rejected the moderate counsel of the planter class their traditional leaders and embraced the demagogues fiery gospel of resentment It was this troubling altered South that LeRoy Percy bequeathed to his son William Alexander Will Percy fought in World War I taught for a time and stood at his father's side throughout many of the battles to safeguard the delta from extremism But Will's true calling was as a poet and his lasting contribution to the delta would be in the form of a memorial to its past his memoir *Lanterns on the Levee* During my day he wrote Will Percy not long before his death I have witnessed the disintegration of that moral cohesion of the South which had given it its strength and its sons their singleness of purpose and simplicity It would be left to Walker Percy to fully confront this modern disintegrated South to seek in such works as *The Moviegoer* *The Last Gentleman* and *The Second Coming* the place of the Percy family's values in a world that has little use for aristocrats

The Fiction of Walker Percy John Edward Hardy, 1987 Hardy's study is concerned only with Percy's fiction rather than his life thought or his essays He covers all six of Percy's novels from *The Moviegoer* 1961 to *The Thanatos Syndrome* 1987 and treats them only as fiction rather than as philosophical disquisitions or religious treatises Hardy presents a close reading of each novel focusing on the internal artistic consistency of the works in regard to their subgenres adopted conventions narrative focus and reader text interactions He reveals Percy as a judicious and knowledgeable practitioner in control of his medium ISBN 0 252 01387 5 24 95

The Dream of Arcady Lucinda Hardwick MacKethan, 1999-03-01 This is a well organized gracefully written account of a significant aspect of Southern fiction and it contains information and incisive commentary that one can find nowhere else Thomas Daniel Young Many southern writers imagined the South as a qualified dream of Arcady They retained the glow of the golden land as a device to expose or rebuke to confront or escape the complexities of the actual times in which they lived *The Dream of Arcady* examines the work of post Civil War southern writers who criticize the myth of the South as pastoral paradise Sooner or later in all their idealized worlds the idyllic vision fades in an inescapable moment of awakening This moment which is central to MacKethan's study produces an atmosphere pastoral in mood and implications Her perspective analysis juxtaposes the responses of Sidney Lanier Joel Chandler Harris and Thomas Nelson Page who contributed to yet hope to transcend

sectionalism with the ambivalent views of black writers Charles Chesnutt and Jean Toomer Considering the writings of the Agrarians William Faulkner and Eudora Welty MacKethan then concludes her study by questioning whether the Arcadian dream still serves the artist of our era as a frame for artistic and ideological purposes **Flannery O'Connor and the Christ-Haunted South** Ralph C. Wood, 2005-05-02 For those looking to deepen their appreciation of Flannery O'Connor Wood shows how this literary icon's stories, novels, and essays impinge on America's cultural and ecclesial condition *The Literary Percys* Bertram Wyatt-Brown, 1994 Few families in America can claim so many gifted writers as the Percys This examines the role of gender and family history in the writings of this exceptional lineage *The Primacy of Persons and the Language of Culture* William H. Poteat, 1993 Building upon the scholarship of Michael Polanyi William Poteat has dedicated himself to offering an alternative model to the Cartesian dichotomy of mind and matter that has dominated Western thought for centuries These essays collected by James Nickell and James Stines cover a wide range of subjects from Poteat's analysis of the epistemological crisis brought on by the Cartesian program to his first attempts at formulating an alternative to the mind/body dichotomy These essays relentlessly diagnose the present situation of Western thought by making explicit the philosophical presuppositions to which it is committed They include theological affirmations, reflections on epistemology, conceptual analyses as well as dialogues with other writers in the field of cultural criticism and linguistic theory such as George Steiner, Noam Chomsky, and Walker Percy Most significant is Poteat's bold affirmation of the primacy of persons and his analysis and critique of our cultural misconstructions of human awareness *The Primacy of Persons and the Language of Culture* provides an excellent introduction to the scholarship of William Poteat It should be of particular interest to scholars of philosophy and theology as well as others who share Poteat's deep concern for the state of human culture

Conversations with Robert Coles Robert Coles, 1992 Robert Coles is a psychiatrist with a novelist's sensibilities Of course everything I come up with he says novelists have known beforehand These twenty-three interviews selected from hundreds that Coles has given disclose not only an illustrious physician trained in pediatrics and psychoanalysis but also a sage whose compassion for children and suffering seems boundless In focusing on a man known mainly as an eminent psychiatrist and author of *The Spiritual Life of Children* and more than fifty other books this collection is a departure from the other books in the *Literary Conversations Series* By no means is Coles best known as a writer of belles lettres as are other figures in this series Yet his varied critical insights and the critical authority with which he approaches literary subjects have enriched American literature Here through the prism of his medical and literary training Coles's conversations reveal his imposing moral vision As he ranges with penetrating wisdom over many subjects children literature, teaching, psychiatry, family he explores the cultural, social, and intellectual dimensions of our lives

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
