Wodehouse,2010-09-23 P G Wodehouse s full name was Sir Pelham Grenville Wodehouse He was born in Guildford Surrey in England in 1881 His friends and family simply called him Plum He was an English writer known for his novels short stories and musical theater Wodehouse had a long career of seventy years and spent much of his life in France and the United States He is best known for his novels and short stories about Jeeves as well as those about Blandings Castle The Jeeves stories are told by a wealthy rather scatter brained Bertie Wooster These stories recount the improbable and unfortunate situations in which he finds himself and the ingenious ways his valet Jeeves is always able to remedy the situation Wodehouse lived in a seaside home in Le Touquet France to avoid the double taxation on his earnings by the UK and the US When World War II broke out Wodehouse was taken prisoner by the Germans in 1940 and spent over a year in prisons in Belgium and then Poland He was released just prior to his 60th birthday When writer Christopher Hitchens was asked to comment about the career of P G Wodehouse he responded There is not and never will be anything to touch him P G Wodehouse died at the age of 93 in Southampton New York **The Most Of P.G.
