***Government:** How society organizes itself and allocates authority to accomplish collective goals

- Gov. benefits for citizens examples: Education, health care, and an infrastructure for transportation

***Politics:** The process of gaining and exercising control within a gov. To achieve goals

- Gov. systems and economic systems get confused for one another because some political thoughts are closely related to some economic systems
 - Ex: Capitalism developed around the same time as democratic republics, self-gov. and natural rights

***John Locke:** "All people have natural rights to life, liberty and property (be free to consent to being governed)"

***Adam Smith:** "All people should be free to acquire property in any way instead of being controlled by the gov"

***Democracy:** Political system where people govern themselves with capitalism

***Socialism:** Economic system where generated wealth are owned by gov's, and not private individuals

***Oligarchy:** Only members of a certain political party or ruling elite can participate in gov Ex: [China=Communist Party]

***Private Goods:** Food, clothing, housing etc are provided in ample supply by private businesses that earn a profit in return

***Public Goods:** Goods that are provided by the gov. and are available to all without charge (national security and education)

***Toll Good:** Goods that are available but only if people can pay the price (private school) vs public school

- Exs of public goods: Emergency services, mail services

***Common Goods:** Goods that people can use free of charge but are of limited supply

Ex: Fish, Clean drinking water -REGULATED ACCESS-

- In the U.S. people elect representatives to city councils, state legislature, and congress (they make laws to govern their jurisdiction)

1. **Local Level:** Funds are allotted for education, police, fire departments and maintenance of public parks (state governments allocate money for roads, bridges, state colleges and universities)
2. **National Level:** Money goes to defense social security, maintenance of federal courts and prisons, and pensions for veterans
3. **Each Level:** Representatives try to secure funding for things that will benefit those who live in the area they represent

Henry, 1999 Activist international statesman reluctant black leader scholar icon father and husband Ralph Bunche is one of the most complicated and fascinating figures in the history of twentieth century America Bunche played a central role in shaping international relations from the 1940s through the 1960s first as chief of the Africa section of the Office of Strategic Services and then as part of the State Department group working to establish the United Nations After moving to the U N as Director of Trusteeship he became the first black Nobel Laureate in 1950 and was subsequently named Undersecretary of the U N For nearly a decade he was the most celebrated contemporary African American both domestically and abroad Today he is virtually forgotten Charles Henry's penetrating biography counters this historical tragedy recapturing the essence of Bunche's service to America and the world Moreover Henry ably demonstrates how Bunche's rise and fall as a public symbol tells us as much about America as it does about Bunche His iconic status like that of other prominent mainstream black figures like Colin Powell required a constant struggle over the relative importance of his racial identity and his national identity Henry's biography shines as both the recovered story of a classic American and as a case study in the racial politics of public service
