Gabrielle Starr, 2023-06-06 Literature and neuroscience come together to illuminate the human experience of beauty which unfolds in time How does beauty exist in time This is Gabrielle Starr's central concern in Just in Time as she explores the experience of beauty not as an abstraction but as the result of psychological and neurological processes in which time is central Starr shows that aesthetic experience has temporal scale Starr a literary scholar and pioneer in the field and method of neuroaesthetics which seeks the neurological basis of aesthetic experience applies this methodology to the study of beauty in literature considering such authors as Rita Dove Gerard Manley Hopkins Henry James Toni Morrison and Wallace Stevens as well as the artists Dawoud Bey and Jasper Johns Just in Time is richly informed by the methods and findings of neuroscientists whose instruments let them investigate encounters with art down to the millisecond but Starr goes beyond the laboratory to explore engagements with art that unfold over durations experiments cannot accommodate In neuroaesthetics Starr shows us the techniques of the empirical sciences and humanistic interpretation support and complement one another To understand the temporal quality of aesthetic experience we need both cognitive and phenomenological approaches and this book moves boldly toward their synthesis

McQuilten, Anthony White, 2024-08-22 Art is produced circulated consumed and disseminated within an economic system it depends on money for its creation for the livelihood of its makers and for its distribution In this sense art can be understood as an enterprising activity However profit making is rarely the primary goal of artists and indeed the entanglement of art with enterprise generates significant aesthetic conceptual philosophical and ethical challenges for contemporary art practice Social enterprise has emerged from this complex terrain with the promise of an alternative model of economic organisation in the arts Grace McQuilten and Anthony White argue that artists can and have engaged critically in the commercial market by way of this model Art as Enterprise brings a fresh perspective to the debate about the roles of contemporary art in consumer capitalist society

**Without Alibi** Jacques Derrida, Peggy Kamuf, 2002 This book brings together for the first time five recent essays by Jacques Derrida which advance his reflections on many issues lying perjury forgiveness confession the profession of faith and most recently cruelty sovereignty and capital punishment Strongly linked by their attention to performatives and the as if the essays show the necessity of thinking beyond the category of acts that are possible for a subject Derrida argues forcefully that thought must engage with the impossible that is the order of the unforeseeable event the absolute future still to come This acute awareness of the limits of performative programs informs the essays throughout and attunes them closely to events of a world undergoing globalization The first essay History of the Lie reviews some classic and modern definitions of the lie Augustine Rousseau Kant Koyr Arendt while renewing questions about what is called lying as distinguished from other forms of nontruth This inventive analysis is followed by Typewriter Ribbon which examines at length the famous lie recounted by Rousseau in his Confessions when he perjured himself by accusing another of his own crime Paul de Man s reading of this textual event is at the center of Derrida s patient at times seriously funny analyses Le parjure Perhaps engages with a remarkable novel by Henri Thomas that fictionalizes the charge of perjury brought against Paul de Man in the 1950s Derrida s extraordinary fineness as a reader and thinker of fiction here treats to profound effect the fatal experience of perjury The two final essays The University Without Condition and Psychoanalysis Searches the States of Its Soul address the institutions of the university and of psychoanalysis as sites from which to resist and deconstruct the nontruth or phantasm of sovereignty For the university the principle of truth remains at the core of its resistance for psychoanalysis there is the obligation to remain true to what may

be Derrida suggests its specific insight into psychic cruelty Resistance to the sovereign cruelty of the death penalty is just one of the stakes indicated by the last essay which is the text of a keynote address to the States General of Psychoanalysis held in Paris July 2000 Especially for this volume Derrida has written Provocation Forewords which reflects on the title Without Alibi while taking up questions about relations between deconstruction and America This essay foreword also responds to the event of this book which Peggy Kamuf in her introduction presents as event of resistance Without Alibi joins two other books by Derrida that Kamuf has translated for Stanford University Press Points Interviews 1974 1994 1994 and Resistances of Psychoanalysis 1998

objects which did not have the source of their own production within themselves This book the first of three volumes revises the Aristotelian argument and develops an innovative assessment whereby the technical object can be seen as having an essential distinct temporality and dynamics of its own The Aristotelian concept persisted in one form or another until Marx who conceived of the possibility of an evolution of technics Lodged between mechanics and biology a technical entity became a complex of heterogeneous forces In a parallel development while industrialization was in the process of overthrowing the contemporary order of knowledge as well as contemporary social organization technology was acquiring a new place in philosophical questioning Philosophy was for the first time faced with a world in which technical expansion was so widespread that science was becoming more and more subject to the field of instrumentality with its ends determined by the imperatives of economic struggle or war and with its epistemic status changing accordingly The power that emerged from this new relation was unleashed in the course of the two world wars Working his way through the history of the Aristotelian assessment of technics the author engages the ideas of a wide range of thinkers Rousseau Husserl and Heidegger the paleo ontologist Leroi Gourhan the anthropologists Vernant and Detienne the sociologists Weber and Habermas and the systems analysts Maturana and Varela
