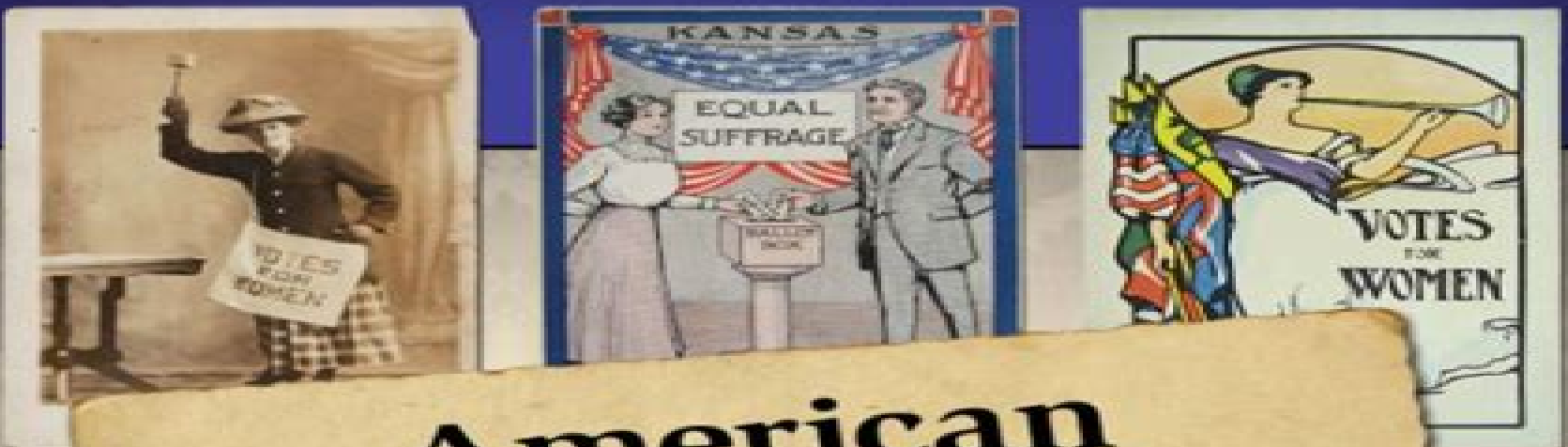

American Woman Suffrage Postcards Kenneth Florey, 2016-04-29 American women's suffrage activists were fascinated with suffrage themed postcards. They collected them, exchanged them, wrote about them, used them as fundraisers, and organized postcard day campaigns. The cards they produced were imaginative and ideological, advancing arguments for the enfranchisement of women and responding to antisuffrage broadsides. Commercial publishers were also interested in suffrage cards, recognizing their profit potential. Their products though, were reactive rather than proactive, conveying stereotypes they assumed reflected public attitudes, often negative towards the movement. Cataloging approximately 700 examples, this study examines the visual rhetoric of suffrage postcards in the context of the movement itself and as part of the general history of postcards.

Women's Suffrage in the Americas Stephanie Mitchell, 2024-07-01 The first hemispheric study to trace how women in the Americas obtained the right to vote, *Women's Suffrage in the Americas* pushes back against the misconception that women's movements originated in the United States. The volume brings Latin American voices to the forefront of English language scholarship. Suffragists across the hemisphere worked together, formed collegial networks to support each other's work, and fostered advances toward women gaining the vote over time and space from one country to the next. The collection as a whole suggests several models by which women in the Americas gained the right to vote: through party politics, through decree despite delays justified by women's supposed conservative politics, through conservative defense of traditional roles for women, and within the context of imperialism. However, until now, historians have traditionally failed to view this common history through a hemispheric lens.

Lydia Pyne, 2022-11-01 3 100 2021 IG 19 20 21 21 IG 19 20 19 20 *An Unfinished Revolution* Marguerite Kearns, 2021-06-01 Through the lens of one family's history *An Unfinished Revolution* tells the story of the suffrage movement and the ongoing struggle for women's rights in the United States The book opens with ten year old Marguerite Kearns listening to her grandfather Wilmer's stories about how he met her grandmother Edna a ninth generation Quaker and ardent suffrage campaigner and how he fell in love with her Wilmer who became a male suffrage activist himself also shares the story of the Spirit of 1776 suffrage campaign wagon that Edna and others used while organizing in New York State in 1913 After sitting for years in a Kearns family garage the wagon is currently housed in the permanent collection of the New York State Museum as a prime artifact in the national suffrage movement As Marguerite grows older she draws on a wide variety of sources from family stories and photographs to archives and scholarly histories to piece together the real life narrative of her family Profoundly changed in the process she becomes an activist herself and when she marches in a present day women's march she carries a photo of her grandparents participating in a 1914 women's march in New York With the women's suffrage movement as the backdrop this memoir and family history illuminates how activism passes from one generation to another and how a horse drawn suffrage campaign wagon became a symbol of freedom and equality
