

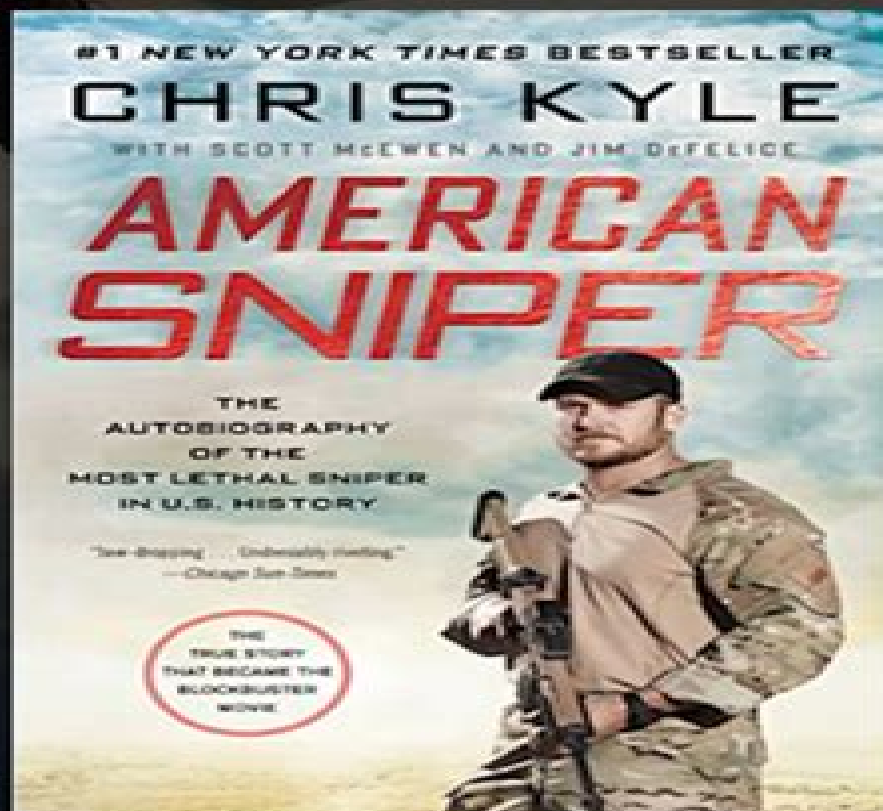

different ways and there is no ultimate authority on the experiences of any war curators of war objects make different choices about what to display or write about none of which are entirely problematic good or accurate This book asks whose vantage points on war are made available and where for public consumption it also questions whose war experiences are not represented are minimized or ignored in ways that advantage contemporary militarism Christine Sylvester looks at four sites of war memory the National Museum of American History the Vietnam Veterans Memorial Arlington National Cemetery and selected novels and memoirs of the American wars in Vietnam and Iraq to consider the way war knowledge is embedded in differing sites of memory and display While the museum shows war aircraft and a laptop computer used by a journalist covering the American war in Iraq visitors to the Vietnam Memorial or Arlington Cemetery find more prosaic and civilian items on view such as baby pictures slices of birthday cake or even car keys In addition memoirs and novels of these wars tend to curate ghastly horrors of wars as experienced by soldiers or civilians For Sylvester these sites of war memory and curation provide ways to understand dispersed war authority and interpretation and to consider which sites invite viewers to revere a war and which reflect personal experiences that show the undersides of these wars Sylvester shows that scholars policymakers and other citizens need to consider different types of situated memory and knowledge in order to fully grasp war rather than idealize it

Combat Trauma Nadia Abu El-Haj, 2022-09-27 Americans have long been asked to support the troops and care for veterans psychological wounds Who though does this injunction serve As acclaimed scholar Nadia Abu El Haj argues here in the American public s imagination the traumatized soldier stands in for destructive wars abroad with decisive ramifications in the post 9 11 era Across the political spectrum the language of soldier trauma is used to discuss American warfare producing a narrative in which traumatized soldiers are the only acknowledged casualties of war while those killed by American firepower are largely sidelined and forgotten In this wide ranging and fascinating study of the meshing of medicine science and politics Abu El Haj explores the concept of post traumatic stress disorder and the history of its medical diagnosis While antiwar Vietnam War veterans sought to address their psychological pain even as they maintained full awareness of their guilt and responsibility for perpetrating atrocities on the killing fields of Vietnam by the 1980s a peculiar convergence of feminist activism against sexual violence and Reagan s right wing war on crime transformed the idea of PTSD into a condition of victimhood In so doing the meaning of Vietnam veterans trauma would also shift moving away from a political space of reckoning with guilt and complicity to one that cast them as blameless victims of a hostile public upon their return home This is how in the post 9 11 era of the Wars on Terror the injunction to support our troops came to both sustain US militarism and also shields American civilians from the reality of wars fought ostensibly in their name In this compelling and crucial account Nadia Abu El Haj challenges us to think anew about the devastations of the post 9 11 era

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
