comes within the range of intertextuality per se is widened to cover artistic dialogism In the exchanges between theatrical texts reprise may be construed as a metaphor standing for the pleasure inherent in the process of recreation The interaction between embedded paintings and the embedding canvas offers yet another variation on the reprise motif as does the meta aesthetic discourse of the critic on the work of art What begins as mere repetition is soon colored by the personal inflections of the interpreter In operatic performances updating a classical text to make it suitable to contemporary audiences and in close harmony with the role assigned to music is liable to spur on the creativity of recreation
