Thomas More on Statesmanship Gerard B.

Wegemer, 1998. The term statesman entered the English language during the Renaissance as a result of the widespread return to the Greek and Roman classics. Sir Thomas More, who brought his careful study of Plato and Aristotle, Cicero, and Augustine to bear upon his political life, contributed most to the recovery of the ancient Greco-Roman concept of the statesman. He believed that the essential work of the statesman is to draw upon the nation's deepest and longest-standing consensus, as expressed in its literature and its laws, in order to govern with the people's consent. More was convinced that law, not individual persons, should rule.
