A Palace for a King Jonathan Brown, John Huxtable Elliott, 2003-01-01 The Buen Retiro a royal retreat and pleasure palace was built for Philip IV on the outskirts of Madrid in the 1630s With its superb display of paintings by Velázquez and other contemporary artists the palace became a showcase for the art and culture of Spain's Golden Age A Palace for a King first published in 1980 provides a pioneering total history of the construction decoration and uses of a major royal palace emphasising the relationship of art and politics at a critical moment in European history produced on different aspects of the history of the palace and its decoration since the 1970s A number of new unpublished illustrations have been added and many of the plates are now reproduced in colour The publication of this edition gains added importance from the fact that plans for the expansion of the Prado Museum include the restoration of the Hall of Realms to approximate its original appearance as reconstructed in this volume

Anthropology's Global Histories Rainer F. Buschmann, 2008-10-31 Anthropologists and world historians make strange bedfellows Although the latter frequently employ anthropological methods in their descriptions of cross cultural exchanges the former have raised substantial reservations about global approaches to history Fearing loss of specificity anthropologists object to the effacing qualities of techniques employed by world historians this despite the fact that anthropology itself was a global comparative enterprise in the nineteenth century Rainer Buschmann here seeks to recover some of anthropology's global flavor by viewing its history in Oceania through the notion of the ethnographic frontier the furthestmost limits of the anthropologically known regions of the Pacific The colony of German New Guinea 1884-1914 presents an ideal example of just such a contact zone Colonial administrators there were drawn to approaches partially inspired by anthropology Anthropologists and museum officials exploited this interest by preparing large scale expeditions to German New Guinea Buschmann explores the resulting interactions between German colonial officials resident ethnographic collectors and indigenous peoples arguing that all were instrumental in the formation of anthropological theory He shows how changes in collecting aims and methods helped shift ethnographic study away from its focus on material artifacts to a broader consideration of indigenous culture He also shows how ethnological collecting often a competitive affair could become politicized and connect to national concerns Finally he places the German experience in the broader context of Euro American anthropology Anthropology's Global Histories will interest students and scholars of anthropology history world history and Pacific studies

Civic Discipline Karen M. Morin, 2016-05-23 The American Geographical Society was the pre eminent geographical society in the nineteenth century U S This book explores how geographical knowledge and practices took shape as a civic enterprise under the leadership of Charles P. of civic and social reform causes resonated closely with his work as geographer such as his influence in tenement housing and street sanitation reform in New York City Others of his projects served commercial interests including in American railroad development and colonization of the African Congo Daly was also New York's most influential access point to the Arctic in the latter nineteenth century Through telling the story of the nineteenth century AGS and Charles Daly this book provides a critical appraisal of the role of particular actors institutions and practices involved in the development and promotion of geography in the mid nineteenth century U S that is long overdue

Brown, 2012 Historically food security was the responsibility of ministries of agriculture but today that has changed decisions made in ministries of energy may instead have the greatest effect on the food situation Recent research reporting that a one degree Celsius rise in temperature can reduce grain yields by 10 per cent means that energy policy is now directly affecting crop production Agriculture is a water intensive activity and while public attention has focused on oil depletion it is aquifer depletion that poses the more serious threat There are substitutes for oil but none for water and the link between our fossil fuel addiction climate change and food security is now clear While population growth has slowed over the past three decades we are still adding 76 million people per year In a world where the historical rise in land productivity has slowed by half since 1990 eradicating hunger may depend as much on family planners as on farmers The bottom line is that future food security depends not only on efforts within agriculture but
