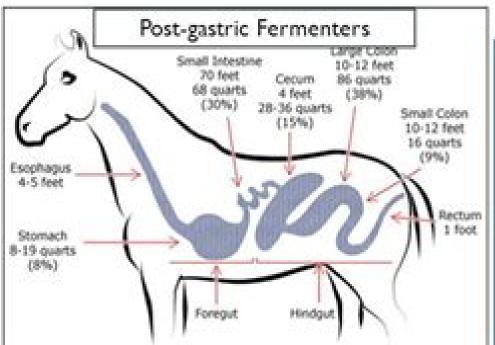


FIGURE 1. A basic diagram of the digestive system of a hog.



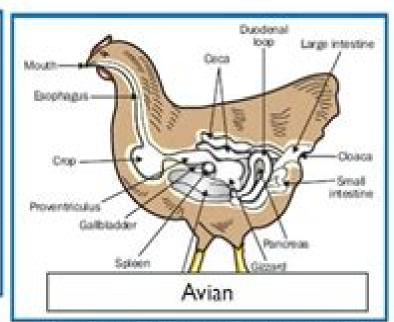
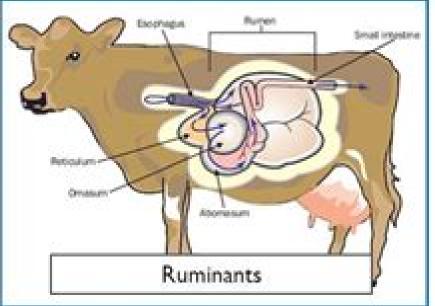


FIGURE 2. A basic diagram of the digestive system of a chicken.
