Virginia Woolf's third novel *Jacob's Room* (1922) is a penetrating look at one man's life from childhood until his untimely death in the first World War. On the surface this could be considered an anti-war novel yet it is a wildly inventive experimental work that dispels traditional forms of narration. The nebulous central character Jacob Flanders is strangely absent from the novel yet the spaces he traversed are not. In telling the story of Jacob through the perspective of the characters he encountered through his short life, Woolf has created an exceptional contemplation of memory, time and identity. Subverting the Bildungsroman genre, *Jacob's Room* recounts a short and unsettled life through related incidents, fleeting impressions and delirious stream-of-consciousness passages. Through an almost cinematic lens, glimpses of Jacob's early life are recollected through his mother: the idyllic time spent with her children and her uneasy experiences living a widower's life. Through other voices, Jacob arrives at Cambridge where he is able to socially integrate despite his humble upbringings. After graduating, he leaves for London where he interacts with a wide range of individuals, both impoverished and from the wealthy class, yet he never fully connects to a meaningful human relationship.
