in the book that finally resulted his excellent notes on the history of the Weil conjectures as a second introduction Our original notes were written in German However we finally followed the recommendation made variously to publish the book in English We had the good fortune that Professor W Waterhouse and his wife Betty agreed to translate our manuscript We want to thank them very warmly for their willing involvement in such a tedious task We are very grateful to the staff of Springer Verlag for their careful work
