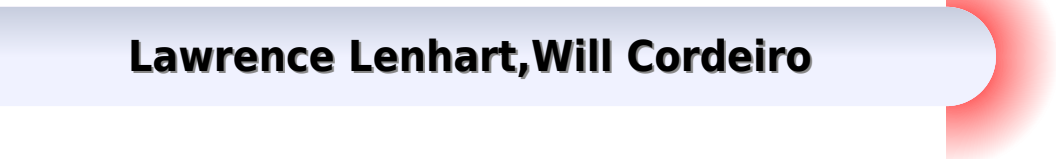

absence of clutter Paul Stephens,2020-03-24 An exploration of minimal writing texts generally shorter than a sentence as complex powerful literary and visual works In the 1960s and 70s minimal and conceptual artists stripped language down to its most basic components the word and the letter Barbara Kruger Jenny Holzer Carl Andre Lawrence Weiner and others built lucrative careers from text based art Meanwhile poets and writers created works of minimal writing visual texts generally shorter than a sentence One poem by Aram Saroyan reads in its entirety eyeye In absence of clutter Paul Stephens offers the first comprehensive account of minimal writing arguing that
