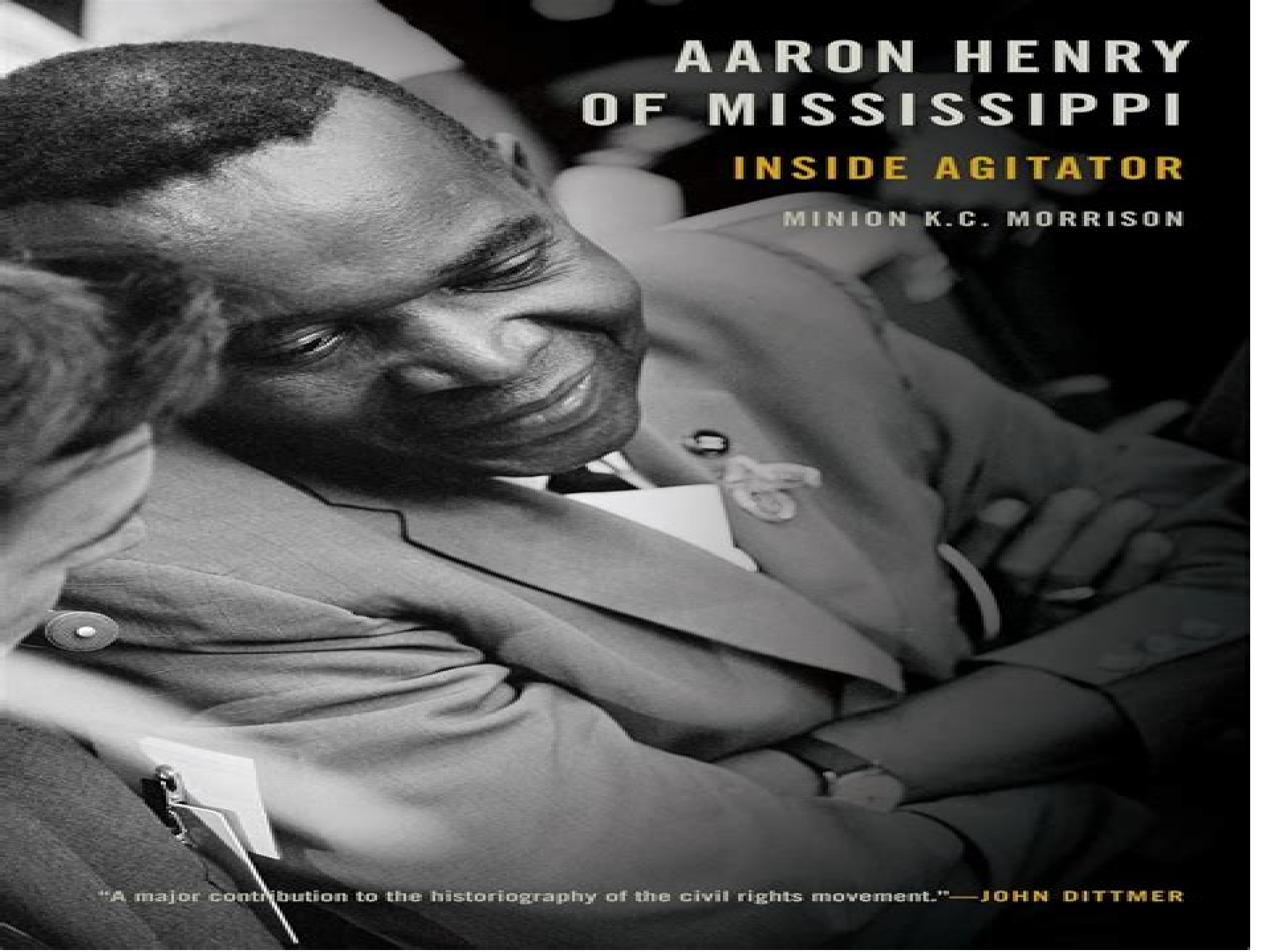

Aaron Henry of Mississippi Minion K. C. Morrison, 2015-06-05 Winner of the 2016 Lillian Smith Book Award When Aaron Henry returned home to Mississippi from World War II service in 1946 he was part of wave of black servicemen who challenged the racial status quo He became a pharmacist through the GI Bill and as a prominent citizen he organized a hometown chapter of the NAACP and relatively quickly became leader of the state chapter From that launching pad he joined and helped lead an ensemble of activists who fundamentally challenged the system of segregation and the almost total exclusion of African Americans from the political structure These efforts were most clearly evident in his leadership of the integrated Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party delegation which after an unsuccessful effort to unseat the lily white Democratic delegation at the Democratic National Convention in 1964 won recognition from the national party in 1968 The man who the New York Times described as being at the forefront of every significant boycott sit in protest march rally voter registration drive and court case eventually became a rare example of a social movement leader who successfully moved into political office Aaron Henry of Mississippi covers the life of this remarkable leader from his humble beginnings in a sharecropping family to his election to the Mississippi house of representatives in 1979 all the while maintaining the social change ideology that prompted him to improve his native state and thereby the nation *Black Lives Matter in Latin*

Smith II, 2023-08-29 This book unearths a food story buried deep within the soil of American civil rights history Drawing on archival research interviews and oral histories Bobby J Smith II re examines the Mississippi civil rights movement as a period when activists expanded the meaning of civil rights to address food as integral to sociopolitical and economic conditions For decades white economic and political actors used food as a weapon against Black sharecropping communities in the Yazoo Mississippi Delta but members of these communities collaborated with activists to transform food into a tool of resistance Today Black youth are building a food justice movement in the Delta to continue this story grappling with inequalities that continue to shape their lives Drawing on multiple disciplines including critical food studies Black studies history sociology and southern studies Smith makes critical connections between civil rights activism and present day

Walk with Me Kate Clifford Larson, 2021 Few figures embody the physical courage unstinting sacrifice and inspired heroism behind the Civil Rights movement more than Fannie Lou Hamer For millions hers was the voice that made This Little Light of Mine an anthem Her impassioned rhetoric electrified audiences At the Democratic Convention in 1964 Hamer s televised speech took not just Democrats but the entire nation to task for abetting racial injustice searing the conscience of everyone who heard it Born in the Mississippi Delta in 1917 Hamer was the 20th child of Black sharecroppers and raised in a world in which racism poverty and injustice permeated the cotton fields As the Civil Rights Movement began to emerge during the 1950s she was struggling to make a living with her husband on lands that her forebears had cleared ploughed and harvested for generations When a white doctor sterilized her without her permission in 1961 Hamer took her destiny into her own hands Bestselling biographer Kate Clifford Larson offers the first account of Hamer s life for a general audience capturing and illuminating what made Hamer the electrifying force that she became when she walked onto stages across the country during the 1960s and until her death in 1977 *Walk with Me* does justice to the full force of Hamer s activism and example Based on new sources including recently opened FBI files and Oval Office transcripts the biography features interviews with some of the people closest to Hamer and conversations with Civil Rights leaders who fought alongside her Larson s biography will become the standard account of an extraordinary life

Brother Outsider, Brother Insider Chris Danielson, 2025-07 Lawrence Thomas Guyot Jr 1939 2012 known simply as Guyot pronounced ghee aught was a pivotal yet underrecognized figure in the civil rights movement As a Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee SNCC field secretary in the 1960s he battled southern poverty and racism championing voting rights for Black Mississippians His leadership in the Mississippi Freedom Democratic Party MFDP highlighted tensions between the MFDP s electoral goals and SNCC s more radical stance Guyot later moved into Washington DC politics working alongside leaders like Marion Barry shifting from a rural civil rights organizer to an urban political strategist Chris Danielson s nuanced portrayal of Guyot offers a fresh perspective on the civil rights movement Through Guyot s activism *Brother Outsider Brother Insider* invites a reassessment of the era and the individuals who shaped it

Black Bodies in the River Davis W. Houck, 2022-06-27 Nearly sixty years after Freedom Summer its events especially the lynching of Andrew Goodman James Chaney and Mickey Schwerner stand out as a critical episode of the civil rights movement The infamous deaths of these activists dominate not just the history but also the public memory of the Mississippi Summer Project Beginning in the late 1970s however movement veterans challenged this central narrative with the shocking claim that during the search for Goodman Chaney and Schwerner the FBI and other law enforcement personnel discovered many unidentified Black bodies in Mississippi s swamps rivers and bayous This claim has evolved in subsequent years as activists journalists filmmakers and scholars have

continued to repeat it and the number of supposed Black bodies never identified has grown from five to more than two dozen In *Black Bodies in the River Searching for Freedom* Summer author Davis W Houck sets out to answer two questions Were Black bodies discovered that summer And why has the shocking claim only grown in the past several decades despite evidence to the contrary In other words what rhetorical work does the Black bodies claim do and with what audiences Houck s story begins in the murky backwaters of the Mississippi River and the discovery of the bodies of Henry Dee and Charles Moore murdered on May 2 1964 by the Ku Klux Klan He pivots next to the Council of Federated Organization s voter registration efforts in Mississippi leading up to Freedom Summer He considers the extent to which violence generally and expectations about interracial violence in particular serve as a critical context for the strategy and rhetoric of the Summer Project Houck then interrogates the unnamed Black bodies claim from a historical and rhetorical perspective illustrating that the historicity of the bodies in question is perhaps less the point than the critique of who we remember from that summer and how we remember them Houck examines how different memory texts filmic landscape presidential speech and museums function both to bolster and question the centrality of murdered white men in the legacy of Freedom Summer

Political Black Girl Magic Sharon D. Wright Austin, Pearl K. Dowe, 2023-06-02 Examines the experiences of Black female mayors in the contexts of their campaigns and of their governance seeking to understand how race gender or the combination of both have affected them and to identify the most significant obstacles Black women have faced as mayors and mayoral candidates

House of Diggs Marion Orr, 2025-08-20 At the height of the civil rights movement Charles C Diggs Jr 1922 1998 was the consummate power broker In a political career spanning 1951 to 1980 Diggs Michigan s first Black member of Congress was the only federal official to attend the trial of Emmett Till s killers worked behind the scenes with Martin Luther King Jr and founded the Congressional Black Caucus He was also the chief architect of legislation that restored home rule to Washington DC and almost single handedly ignited the American anti apartheid movement in the 1960s Drawing on extensive archival research including Diggs s rarely seen personal papers FBI documents and original interviews with family members and political associates political scientist Marion Orr reveals that Diggs practiced a politics of strategic moderation Orr argues that this quiet approach was more effective than the militant race politics practiced by Adam Clayton Powell and more appealing than the conservative Chicago style approach of William Dawson two of Diggs s better known Black contemporaries Vividly written and deeply researched *House of Diggs* is the first biography of Congressman Charles C Diggs Jr one of the most consequential Black federal legislators in US history Congressman Diggs was a legislative lion whose unfortunate downfall punctuated his distinguished career and pushed him and his historic accomplishments out of sight Now for the first time *House of Diggs* restores him to his much deserved place in the history of American politics I've Got the Light of Freedom Charles M. Payne, 1995 This momentous work offers a groundbreaking history of the early civil rights movement in the South Using wide ranging archival work and extensive interviews with movement participants Charles

Payne uncovers a chapter of American social history forged locally in places like Greenwood Mississippi where countless unsung African Americans risked their lives for the freedom struggle The leaders were ordinary women and men sharecroppers domestics high school students beauticians independent farmers committed to organizing the civil rights struggle house by house block by block relationship by relationship Payne brilliantly brings to life the tradition of grassroots African American activism long practiced yet poorly understood Payne overturns familiar ideas about community activism in the 1960s The young organizers who were the engines of change in the state were not following any charismatic national leader Far from being a complete break with the past their work was based directly on the work of an older generation of activists people like Ella Baker Septima Clark Amzie Moore Medgar Evers Aaron Henry These leaders set the standards of courage against which young organizers judged themselves they served as models of activism that balanced humanism with militance While historians have commonly portrayed the movement leadership as male ministerial and well educated Payne finds that organizers in Mississippi and elsewhere in the most dangerous parts of the South looked for leadership to working class rural Blacks and especially to women Payne also finds that Black churches typically portrayed as frontrunners in the civil rights struggle were in fact late supporters of the movement *The War on Poverty in Mississippi* Emma J.

Folwell,2020-03-18 President Lyndon B Johnson s war on poverty instigated a ferocious backlash in Mississippi Federally funded programs the embodiment of 1960s liberalism directly clashed with Mississippi s closed society From 1965 to 1973 opposing forces transformed the state In this state level history of the war on poverty Emma J Folwell traces the attempts of white and black Mississippians to address the state s dire economic circumstances through antipoverty programs At times the war on poverty became a powerful tool for black empowerment But more often antipoverty programs served as a potent catalyst of white resistance to black advancement After the momentous events of 1964 both black activism and white opposition to black empowerment evolved due to these federal efforts White Mississippians deployed massive resistance in part to stifle any black economic empowerment twisting antipoverty programs into tools to marginalize black political power Folwell uncovers how the grassroots war against the war on poverty laid the foundation for the fight against 1960s liberalism as Mississippi became a national model for stonewalling social change As Folwell indicates many white Mississippians hardwired elements of massive resistance into the political economic and social structure Meanwhile they abandoned the Democratic Party and honed the state s Republican Party spurred by a new conservatism *Delta Epiphany* Ellen B.

Meacham,2018-04-02 In April 1967 a year before his run for president Senator Robert F Kennedy knelt in a crumbling shack in Mississippi trying to coax a response from a listless child The toddler sat picking at dried rice and beans spilled over the dirt floor as Kennedy former US attorney general and brother to a president touched the boy s distended stomach and stroked his face and hair After several minutes with little response the senator walked out the back door wiping away tears In *Delta Epiphany* Robert F Kennedy in Mississippi Ellen B Meacham tells the story of Kennedy s visit to the Delta while also

examining the forces of history economics and politics that shaped the lives of the children he met in Mississippi in 1967 and the decades that followed The book includes thirty seven powerful photographs a dozen published here for the first time Kennedy s visit to the Mississippi Delta as part of a Senate subcommittee investigation of poverty programs lasted only a few hours but Kennedy the people he encountered Mississippi and the nation felt the impact of that journey for much longer His visit and its aftermath crystallized many of the domestic issues that later moved Kennedy toward his candidacy for the presidency Upon his return to Washington Kennedy immediately began seeking ways to help the children he met on his visit however his efforts were frustrated by institutional obstacles and blocked by powerful men who were indifferent and at times hostile to the plight of poor black children Sadly we know what happened to Kennedy but this book also introduces us to three of the children he met on his visit including the baby on the floor and finishes their stories Kennedy talked about what he had seen in Mississippi for the remaining fourteen months of his life His vision for America was shaped by the plight of the hungry children he encountered there Men Like That John Howard,2001-10-10 As Howard recounts the life stories of the ordinary and the famous often in their own words he also locates the material traces of queer sexuality in the landscape from the farmhouse to the church social from sports facilities to roadside rest areas Jacket **Ronald W. Big Jim Eastland J. Lee Annis Jr., 2016-07-21 For decades after the Second World War, Senator James O. Eastland (1904-1986) was one of the more intransigent leaders of the Deep South's resistance to what he called the Second Reconstruction. And yet, he developed late in his life a very real friendship with state NAACP chair Aaron Henry. *Big Jim Eastland* provides the life story of this savvy, unpredictable powerhouse. From 1947 to 1978, Eastland wore that image of resistance proudly, even while recognizing from the beginning that he was on the losing side. Biographer J. Lee Annis Jr. chronicles such complexities extensively and also delves into many facets lesser known to the general public. Born in the Mississippi Delta as part of the elite planter class, Eastland was appointed to the US Senate in 1941 by Democratic Governor Paul B. Johnson Sr. Eastland ran for and won the Senate seat outright in 1942 and served in the Senate from 1943 until his retirement in 1978. A blunt man of few words but many contradictions, Eastland was an important player in Washington from his initial stint in 1941, where he rapidly salvaged several key local projects from bungling intervention, to the 1970s when he shepherded the Supreme Court nominees of Richard Nixon and Gerald Ford to Senate confirmation. Annis paints a full picture of the man, describing the objections Eastland raised to civil rights proposals and the eventual accommodations he needed to accept after the passage of the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

God's Long Summer Charles Marsh, 2024-08-06 In the summer of 1964, the turmoil of the civil rights movement reached its peak in Mississippi, with activists across the political spectrum claiming that God was on their side in the struggle over racial justice. This was the summer when violence against blacks increased at an alarming rate and when the murder of three civil rights workers in Mississippi resulted in national media attention.
